



Block of the Month





separate it into three sections, then put the sections together. Use ¼" seams. Press towards the darker fabric or press open to reduce bulk.

- 1. Create the nose of the rocket using (2) HST Create the nose of the rocket using (2) HST that will be 2" (unfinished size). To do that, use the '2 at a time' method using a 3" piece of sky and a 3" piece of nose. With right sides together, draw a diagonal time ecross the wrong side of sky. Then sew %" across the wrong side of sky. Hen sew M: on both sides of that line. Cut the fabric on drawn line. Press then trim to get 2" squares. Sew both squares together to form the nose. 2. Next sew on a 3.5" x 1" piece of fabric (top
- band) to the nose.
- 3. Sew together (3) different color strips of fabric, each 1.5" x 5". Press. Now cut this assembly into a 3.5" x 3.5" piece (save the other for Section 2). Sew onto the other. side of the top band.
 4. Sew a 3" x 6" piece of sky fabric to each
- side of rocket.

Section 2: Wing Assembly

- 5. Cut the remaining strip assembly from step 3 into a piece that measures 3.5" x 2". Sew a 3.5" x 1" of fabric (second band) onto this strip assembly.
- To create the two wings, you need a piece of sky material 3"x 2.5" and a piece of wing of sky material 3" x 2.5" and a piece of twing material 2.5" square for each side. Draw a diagonal on the wrong side of the wing square. Placing right sides together, sew them together on the drawn line. Then cut '4" from line, and fold & press wing. You will have a piece that is 3" x 2.5" to go one side of the rocket. Important: When doing the second wing, please note the orientation will be different on the other side, so position the square and the drawn diagonally accordingly!

- 7. Sew a piece of sky 3" x 1" on both of each wing from step 6.
- 8. Now sew both wings onto each side of the bottom rocket body.

- 9. Using the Ouick 4-at-a-Time Geese Using the Quick 4-st-a-Time Geese Method, starting with the exhaust square as 3.25" and the sky squares at 1.78"; create (4) 1"x 2" (finished size) flying geese. Sow two geese together (as shown in the picture) to form each side of the
- 10. Sew a piece of sky fabric 1.5" x 2.5" in the middle of each exhaust assembly,
 11. Sew a piece of sky fabric 5.5" x 1" to the
- bottom of the whole exhaust assembly.
- 12. Sew a piece of sky fabric 2" x 3" to each side of exhaust assembly.

to the bottom. Then sew 1.5" border around whole unit, The ending block is approximately 10.5" x 13" $\,$ trim if necessary. I know, a lot of steps but it's worth it! Thanks for participating!

July 11: Nancy Barker is teaching the Maple Leaf Log Cabin quilt after the July meeting.

Below is the supply list. You can sign up at the meeting.

She's a great teacher, and you'll enjoy her class!

The logs are created from four green fabrics going from light to dark and four beiges also going from light to dark. The Lightest would be the Green 1 and Beige 1, the darkest Green 4 and Beige 4. The leaf needs to stand out against the green and beige.

To save time please precut:

1 fabric strip from each green 1 1/2 inches wide 1 fabric strip from each beige 2 inches wide 1 fabric strip from leaf fabric 2 inches wide

Also please bring a temporary fabric marker.
