


We believe that the investment in homegrown leaders will drive sustainable, vibrant communities.

Transformation cannot occur without collaboration. To be successful, we need to reimagine philanthropy. Community Leadership Fellows seeks community investors. We will partner with:


- Investors who have a personal commitment to realizing change on the Westside of Chicago
