How to remove Apple devices from iCloud account(s)

Remove the Device from your Account (directly from the device)

1. Grab your old Apple device and open the Settings app.
2. Tap your [Name/Apple Account] at the very top of the screen.
3. Scroll all the way to the bottom and tap Sign Out.
4. Enter your Apple Account password to turn off Activation Lock.
5. Choose whether you want to keep a copy of your iCloud data on this device (your personal cloud data will still be deleted from iCloud).
6. Tap Sign Out again to confirm.

Remove the Device from your Account (Remotely)

If you gave the device away without signing out, or simply want to check that it is fully removed from your Apple ecosystem, you can check your trusted devices from your current phone or a browser:

From another Apple Device:

1. Open Settings > [Your Name/Apple Account].
2. Scroll down below your device name to view the trusted devices list.
3. Tap your old device, then tap Remove from Account.

From a Web Browser:

1. Visit [iCloud Find Devices](https://icloud.com/find) and sign in.
2. Click All Devices at the top, and select your old device.
3. Click Remove This Device



How to remove Android devices from cloud account(s)

To remove an Android phone from your Google account, you can either sign out remotely from the web or delete the account directly on the device.

Option 1: Remove remotely using a web browser

If you do not have the phone in your hand, you can revoke its access from any device.

1. Go to your Google Account Security page.
2. Scroll down to the Your devices section and click Manage all devices.
3. Select the Android phone you want to remove.
4. Click Sign out and confirm.

Option 2: Remove directly on the Android phone

If you have the physical device, deleting the account removes your emails, contacts, and settings from that specific phone.

1. Open your phone's Settings app.
2. Tap Passwords & accounts (this may also be labeled as Users & accounts, Accounts, or Accounts and backup.)
3. Under the "Accounts" section, tap the Google account you want to remove.
4. Tap Remove account and confirm by tapping it again. (If it is the only account, you may need to enter your screen lock PIN or password.)
