

Reflection on the Gospel for the 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time



On this fourteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time, the Church draws our attention to the need for and importance of peace in our world. We are also reminded that Christ is the source of our peace. In today's gospel, Jesus equips us with the message we must bring to our world: "Peace be with you." It is a gift we must offer to our world.

Jesus knows very well that this is what our world needs most, and he is ever ready to let us have it. With the peace that Christ offers us, we must be prepared to transform our world from a culture of war and hatred to a culture of peace. He invites us to be instruments of his peace. The absence of peace in any heart, family, community, society, or nation leaves it devastated while the presence of peace helps communities to develop and thrive.

With St. Francis of Assisi, let us pray: "Lord, make me an instrument of your peace, where there is hatred, let me sow love; where there is injury, pardon; where there is doubt, faith; where there is despair, hope; where there is darkness, light; and where there is sadness, joy."
