
BG has over 50 years' experience providing a reliable after-hours emergency maintenance service to our NSW Housing Clients'.

WestConnex - Stage 3B -Rozelle Interchange Iron Cove Link & Western Harbor Tunnel Client: John Holland & CPB contractors Joint Venture JHCPB JV

Value: -Ongoing

Scope: Complete Project Plumbing Requirements

Start: Q1 2019

Project Details: Stage one- construction of the M4-M5 Link Tunnels, tunnels between the New M4 at Haberfield and the New M5 at St Peters and stub tunnels to the Rozelle interchange. The contractor on this stage is Lendlease Samsung Bouygues Joint Venture (LSBJV). This stage is being managed by Sydney Motorway Corporation. Stage two - construction of the Rozelle Interchange and Iron Cove Link. The contractor on this stage is John Holland and CPB Contractors Joint Venture. This stage is being managed by Roads and Maritime Services. The Rozelle Interchange and Iron Cove Link is the part of the M4-M5 Link and will provide a new underground motorway interchange to City West Link and provide an underground bypass of Victoria Road between Iron Cove Bridge and Anzac Bridge, with links to the future Western Harbour Tunnel. The interchange in Rozelle will be mostly underground and located at the site of the old Rozelle Rail Yards. By building the interchange mostly underground, the project will deliver new active transport options in Rozelle and up to 10 hectares of new open space.

Project Details: The Bulk Earthworks contract was awarded to CPB Contractors and Lendlease Joint Venture (CPBLL JV) in August 2019. This work involves significant design and construction responsibilities, including moving around 25 million cubic metres of earth to support construction of the major elements of the airport, such as the runway and terminal. Works will also include:survey, investigation and salvage worksvegetation clearingremoving of existing roads, fencing and redundant utilitiesconstruction of temporary site facilities (site offices, carparks and access roads)installation of permanent and temporary drainage





Parramatta Light Rail -Stage 1 - Infrastructure Works

Client: CPB Contractors & Downer Group Joint Venture CPBD JV

Value: -Ongoing

Scope: Ongoing

Start: Q2 2019

Project Details

Parramatta Light Rail is one of the NSW Government's latest major infrastructure projects being delivered to serve a growing Sydney. Light rail will create new communities, connect great places and help both locals and visitors move around and explore what the region has to offer. Stage 1 will connect Westmead to Carlingford via the Parramatta CBD and Camellia with a two-way track spanning 12 kilometres, and is expected to open in 2023. The route will link Parramatta's CBD and train station to the Westmead Precinct, Parramatta North Growth Centre, the new Bankwest Stadium, the Camellia Town Centre, the new Powerhouse Museum and Riverside Theatres, the private and social housing redevelopment at Telopea, Rosehill Gardens Racecourse and three Western Sydney University campuses. By 2026, around 28,000 people will use Parramatta Light Rail every day and an estimated 130,000 people will be living within walking distance of light rail stops. In October 2017, the NSW Government announced the preferred route for Stage 2 which will connect Stage 1 and the Parramatta CBD to Ermington, Melrose Park, Wentworth Point and Sydney Olympic Park along a nine-kilometre route.
