Peoples, Lands & Languages)



adjective

relating to or denoting a family of languages spoken in the Middle East and North Africa. The family is commonly divided into five groups: Semitic, Omotic, Berber, Cushitic, and Chadic. Ancient Egyptian was also a member of this family.

adjective

adjective: Semitic

1. relating to or denoting a family of languages that includes Hebrew, Arabic, and Aramaic and certain ancient languages such as Phoenician and Akkadian, constituting the main subgroup of the Afro-Asiatic family.
2. relating to the peoples who speak Semitic languages, especially Hebrew and Arabic.

Hebrew (hēˈbrō), *n.* 1. a member of the Semitic peoples inhabiting ancient Palestine and claiming descent from Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob; Israelite. 2. a Semitic language of the Afro-Asiatic family, the language of the ancient Hebrews, now the national language of Israel. *Abbr.: Heb., Heb.* — *ad 3. Hebraic*. [*ME Hebreu, var. (with H- < L) of Ebreu < OF < ML Ebrē(us) for L Hebraeus < LGk Hebraios < Aram Hebrai; r. OE Ebrēas (pl.) < ML Ebrēt*]

a thick hairstyle with very tight curls that sticks out all around the head, like the **natural hair of some black people.**
