

What to expect on your Habitat Regina Build Day!

Habitat Regina is in the process of building the 2nd largest build in Canada with a total of 62 townhouse units known as Haultain Crossing located at 1033 Edgar Street. Phase 4 is well underway, and we expect 11 families to move in at the end of November. The volunteer groups will be working with the Habitat Regina crew on flooring and trim as well as kitchen installations. No experience is necessary!!

Location/Time/Food/Parking

Meet at Haultain Crossing (1033 Edgar St at the blue trailer West corner). Parking is available on the street.

- 8:15am-8:30am – sign-in and short safety meeting/discussion
- 10:30am – coffee break
- 12:30pm – Lunch
- 3:30pm – Day Wraps up
- Coffee and Lunch will be provided

What should you bring:

- Long pants (no shorts) and T-shirts must have sleeves (no tank tops).
- Steel toe boots, gloves, hard hats and safety glasses will be provided. If you have your own, please feel free to bring them.
- Water bottle/Travel coffee mug
- Bug Spray/Sunscreen
- Your sense of humor and team spirit
- Please note that we are a scent-free organization. Please refrain from wearing perfume, cologne or scented hand lotions.

What to expect on Build Day: Michael, the Volunteer Host will meet our group at the site at 8:30am. He will have you sign in and complete the waiver forms and then will go over a short safety presentation. The site supervisor will then chat about the tasks for the day and then everyone will move out. The Build Trailer is always open with coffee and snacks, so there is always the opportunity to take a break if required.
