# WHERE HAVE YOU BEEN WEAVING & TIPS/TRICKS A COMBINED FEATURE THIS MONTH

Christy Newman and I had the opportunity to attend a workshop at the home of basket weaver Joni-Dee Ross. She and her husband host an awesome workshop event. Joni-Dee shares many tips and tricks while you are weaving. She offers great food, great weaving and great fellowship. Check out her website for upcoming classes.

Sanding: When sanding bases, rims, and handles you do not need to sand it "to death", you can simply use multiple grades of sand paper. By doing this, you can quickly sand the wood smooth and start weaving. First, use 400 grit sand paper, second, use 800 grit, and third, use 1000 or 1200 grit.

It is amazing once you do this, you will see the difference. I have been sanding for years and never has anyone explained it to me this way and I was able to see the immediate difference. Thank you Joni-Dee for the tip!
