
The next 7/7/7 starts in November with a completed Christmas basket or woven Christmas gift, a list of six more basket projects and \$7.00 for the kitty.

#### **TBG Elections**

Although the term of office is two years, TBG holds an election every year. In even number years we elect a vice-president and treasurer. The slate will be presented at the August meeting with the election to follow at the September meeting. Absentee voting is permissible.

#### VICE PRESIDENT

Presides over any meeting at which the president is unable to attend. Prepares a yearly calendar of events with the president's help and presents the calendar to the board for approval. Contacts and schedules quest teachers as needed. Collects money for classes and reminds participants of their selected classes via meeting announcements, newsletter, emails, and website. Maintains a log of volunteers throughout the year to be used for the volunteer drawings at the August meeting event, or delegates this responsibility to another member. Performs other duties as may be assigned by the president.

#### TREASURER

Records and disperses the funds of the guild and maintains up-to-date financial reports for presentation at each board meeting. Works with the president to create an annual budget to be presented to

the board and general membership.
Presents an annual written financial report to the board and other documentation as required for government filing. Retains all records and passes them on to his/her successor.

The board generally meets at 1 pm prior to the monthly guild meeting with an occasional special meeting (calendar/budget). Attending this meeting is part of the job. This is your opportunity to both contribute and have a say in the direction the guild is taking.

Please let us know if you are interested in running for either office. You may also nominate another person with their permission.
