Ella Mae's Mystery Basket Contest

Ella Mae King challenged her fellow students from the Saturday Tote Basket class to a competition. After discussing how every basket pattern can be modified by the personal touch, the group decided to see who could create the most "outlandish" and the "most beautiful basket". Alice and I decided the competition should be open to everyone planning to attend the August picnic at Billie's and laid down the following rules:

The basket must be woven using the tote base and the spokes and fillers as described below. and will be turned in tagged only with the members phone number encased in a garbage bag. Any basket not meeting these standards will be disqualified from judging. The winners will be rewarded and pictured with their basket in the next issue of the newsletter and on the web.

```
5 3/8" flat reed 26" long (horizontal spokes)
9 3/8" flat reed 20" long (horizontal spokes)
4 3/8" flat reed 16" long (fillers)
```

Soak and mark center of spokes and fillers.

Lay out the horizontal spokes with a filler between each of them. These should be touching. Weave in the vertical spokes starting with the center spoke over the fillers and under the horizontals. Weave in remaining spokes. Base should measure approximately 4" by 9 " wide.

Fold the fillers over to the 3rd spoke, trim excess reed and tuck under all fillers. Crease up the sides. Twine from the outside for two rows.

Start weaving now. Don't let Ella Mae carry off the honors without giving her a lot of competition.

MORE Volunteers Needed for TBG Volunteer Program

The Board announced a new TBG Volunteer Program planned for next year to encourage more active participation and better skill utilization of our new members.
