REGISTRATION:

Registration will be open on Thursday afternoon from 3:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m., Thursday night from 8:00 p.m. until 9:30 p.m. AND Friday morning from 7:00 a.m. until 7:45 a.m. Everyone will need to check in at the registration table prior to going to their first class.

On arrival, please check in at our Guilders' Weave registration table to pick up your welcome bag and name tag. **All students must wear the gold/black neck wallets that were given to you in 2018.** If you were a first-time student last year or are one this year, you will be given a free neck wallet. If you have lost or misplaced yours, replacements will be available for purchase. Nametags must always be worn during the convention.
