SIGN operates a co-ed community based Group Home licensed for up to 6 adolescents ages 12-17. Youth are referred to the SIGN Group Home through the Ministry of Social Services and/or the Sunrise Health Region.

The Group Home provides a caring residential environment to assist the development and growth of youth under our care. We operate under the mandate of Saskatchewan's Child and Family Services Act and various other regulations.

Our goal is to help prepare each resident for a successful return to the care of parents or guardians or, alternatively, to prepare them for more independent living.



Youth may be involved in various counseling services, clubs, or recreational activities outside of the Group Home.



Youth are required to attend school within the community or be involved in a supervised work experience.

The Adolescent Group Home provides a caring, nurturing home, supervised 24 hours a day, where the process of developing healthy relationships is of prominent importance.

The ability to learn life skills, deal with personal issues and take responsibility for their behavior is paramount to the provision of supports to young people. They are encouraged to see each experience as an opportunity to grow and develop.
