- Overall case management for one or more youth;

- Assess, evaluate, plan, and revise youth care/support as directed by the AGH Program Manager or AGH Case Management Supervisor;

- Protect the health and safety of others by adopting safe work practices;
- Collaborate and communicate with coworkers and youth to plan, implement, coordinate, and evaluate youth care;
