## Introduction



Food security is a concern for many individuals and families in Yorkton. Community members seek support from various formal sources, however, the agencies and organizations that provide support are not always aware of each other and the services they provide.

In late May, 2024, the Society for the Involvement of Good Neighbours (SIGN) engaged Suncrest College Applied Research Office to conduct an environmental scan of no cost food resources available in Yorkton. The intent of the scan was to better understand the availability of no cost food and to develop a comprehensive list of agencies and organizations that support community members seeking no cost food.

This report increases awareness of no cost food sources in Yorkton for agencies, organizations, their clients, and the public while quickly identifying areas where additional support may be beneficial. This comprehensive list of agencies and organizations gives no cost food providers a single source of information, resulting in a better understanding of and better overall access to food supports for community members within Yorkton.

## About Suncrest College Applied Research



Suncrest College, formerly Parkland College, has conducted Applied Research in Yorkton and area for over 11 years. For the first 10 years, the majority of applied research focused on agriculture and agriculture-related projects. Beginning in late 2023, the Applied Research Office expanded it's scope to include social sciences and social innovation projects.

The research team on the Yorkton No Cost Food Resources project included one primary researcher and four student researchers. Students conducted research as their workplace training requirement in the Skills for Success for Newcomers course.

## **Project Description**

To gain a comprehensive understanding of the sources of no cost food in Yorkton, a survey was developed and then administered to agencies and organizations known to provide no cost food. Researchers gathered information from each surveyed organization and asked each respondent about other sources of no cost food. Researchers learned of additional organizations in this manner, as well as through word of mouth.

In total, **twelve** local agencies or organizations were surveyed on where, when, how and what types of no cost food they provide to community members.

#### The survey learned three main types of information from each respondent:



#### 1. Location

Respondents provided their physical address, website address (if available), phone number and/or social media contact information



#### 2. Hours of Service

Respondents identified the days and hours they were available to provide service to public or restricted clients




#### 3. Food Provided

Respondents identified the types of food available to clients (hot, cold, full meals, snacks, fresh, non-perishable, etc.)


## **Key Findings - Location**

The City of Yorkton was divided into north and south areas at Broadway Street; Gladstone Ave served as an east-west divider. The majority of service locations for no cost food sources are located north of Broadway Street, with the highest concentration of services available in the northeast. Detailed maps can be found in Appendix A.



75% (9/12) of available sources are located north of Broadway Street

50% (6/12) of available sources are located north of Broadway Street and east of Gladstone Ave

## **Key Findings - Service Hours**

Service times for no cost food are predominantly concentrated during weekday daytime periods. Morning and midday hours are the most common service times. Significant gaps were identified after 4:00pm on weekdays and throughout the weekends. Timetables are found in Appendix B.

Seven organizations serve the public, four organizations serve school children, and one organization, Bruno's Place, serves the public as well as shelter clients.

## Key Findings -Service Hours

#### **RESTRICTED AVAILABILITY**

Three schools and two organizations restrict their services to specific clients. The schools and The Soup Haven cater to school children, families and/or school personnel. Bruno's Place provides full meal services, 3 times a day, to shelter clients.

At least 40% of organizations provide canned items such as fruits, vegetables, soups, and stews, as well as rice, pasta, dried beans, and cereal.

Fresh vegetables are available at 50% of organizations, 60% provide fresh bread, and 75% serve fresh fruit.

Notably, the Yorkton Community Fridge was the only location to include infant food and infant formula on its list of available foods.

#### **Other Restrictions**

Community members can access no cost food at most <u>public organizations</u> on an as needed basis. However, St. Andrew's United Church, Yorkton Dream Centre Church and BGCYorkton may impose restrictions on clients, depending on: 1) resources available, 2) number of times a person accesses resources, or 3) if a person is registered with another food program.

## Final Thoughts

The environmental scan of no cost food sources in Yorkton revealed sources of strength that support community members in need of temporary or ongoing food security hardship. The scan also highlighted opportunities to more evenly distribute services around the city, across organizations, and throughout days of the week and times of the day.

#### Strengths:

- 12 organizations in total
- · Found in all areas of the city
- · Provide wide variety of food items
- · Most organizations found online



#### **Opportunities::**

- 75% of organizations located north of Broadway
- Limited availability on weekday evenings and weekends
- Maximum 2 organizations open weekday mornings to midday
- Bruno's Place plays a substantial role within Yorkton's no cost food ecosystem






