Job Summary

The Society for the Involvement of Good Neighbours (SIGN) is seeking a Youth Care Worker on a casual basis to work within the Adolescent Group Home, which operates a co-ed group home licensed for five adolescents. The home provides a residential group care program to assist the youth in understanding and resolving personal and family issues. The objective of the home is to prepare youth to successfully return to the care of parents or guardians or to provide support to the youth leading to independent living.

The AGH Youth Care Workers, under the direction of the AGH Program Manager, is responsible for the day-to-day residential operation of the Adolescent Group Home. A Youth Care Worker supervises, mentors and cares for the needs of the residents. Youth Care Workers are to role model positive attitudes and behaviours, and strive to develop healthy relationships with each youth, while respecting and protecting the rights of the residents.

The positions are short notice call in to fill shifts for day, evening and/or night rotations. Rate of pay will be as per the Collective Bargaining Agreement with the union.

The successful candidate should have the **Education and Professional Experiences of:**

- Bachelor of Social Work Degree preferred but equivalent in education, training and experience will be considered.
- Working with youth in a residential setting.
- Working effectively as a team member with strong verbal and written communication skills.

And the assets and abilities, inclusive of (but not limited to):

- Collaborating with others to plan, implement, coordinate, and evaluate youth care and support in consultation with the youth and their families.
- Providing direct and comprehensive care and assistance to youth with specialized and complex needs as required.
- Caring for and supervising residents, and ensuring that the nutritional and health requirements are met and maintained
- Recording and reporting all relevant information pertaining to the residents and maintaining necessary files.
- Social and recreation planning and teaching appropriate social skills to residents.
