The Family Preservation Worker, under the direction of the Family Preservation Program Manager, focuses on providing supports and services to vulnerable and at-risk families, through flexible and intensive home visitation, referrals and collaboration with other community services, to assist families to develop the skills necessary to keep children safe and to keep the family intact when it is possible to do so. This position will collaborate with members of an interdisciplinary team to plan, implement, coordinate, and evaluate client care and support in consultation with individuals and their families.
