The Housing Locator will:

- ◆ Assist individuals in finding and maintaining housing
- ◆ Assist with filling out applications
- ◆ Maintain relationships with private and non-private housing providers
- ◆ Provide short-term support to the tenant and landlord relationship, if required
- ◆ Assist housing providers when tenants are in crisis
- ◆ Connect tenants and housing providers to resources in the community
- ◆ Provide a current Housing Directory
- ◆ Provide training and workshops for tenants, housing providers and the community on various housing related topics
