- To say No, Yes, Pass, Goodbye, or I don't know;
- To decide what information you share and have your information kept confidential.

Please note that limits of confidentiality include court orders and/or a duty to report if there is threat or harm.

What we do and how we do it

- We receive referrals from Ministry of Social Service (MSS);
- Trained Family Preservation Workers (FPWs) are matched to each family;
- FPWs work flexible hours to accommodate the family's schedule;
- Communication is ethically documented and reported;
- FPWs provide service to two or three families at a time;
- The family, the MSS caseworker, and the FPW set mutual goals to work towards;
- Safety plans are completed for both physical and emotional safety;
- Tailored services are implemented based on the strengths of the family;
- FPW assesses and provides programming based on the values and needs of the family;
- FPW can provide supervised visits as directed by MSS;
- Various approaches and teaching methods are adapted to the family's learning style;
- Skill development programming is facilitated;
- Collaboration with agencies such as Education, Health and Justice takes place as needed;
- We provide advocacy on behalf of the family;
- Transition to appropriate services takes place at the time of Family Preservation's service closure.

Family Preservation provides a response to family crisis situations to ensure the safety of the children, while allowing them to remain in the home.

Family Preservation Workers provide supports and services to vulnerable and at-risk families, through flexible intensive in-home visitation including referring and collaborating with other community agencies.
