This role will also respect and protect the rights of clients.

The successful candidate should have the Education and Professional Experiences of:

- A Bachelor's Degree, Diploma or Certification and training appropriate to the position.
- A minimum of one (1) year experience working with various children, youth and families.
- Valid driver's license and access to a personal motor vehicle for transportation of clients
- A recent (6 months or less), clear Criminal Record Check and Vulnerable Sector Check is a requirement.

- Support and educate families in parenting, child development, communication skills and relationship building.
- Connect individuals and families to community and professional supports.
- Ability to travel to meet with families in their homes and accommodate family schedules.
- A belief that while many families experience stressors and barriers to a healthy family life, they have strengths to build on.
- Ability to deal pleasantly and effectively with a wide range of people of different ages and cultures, in potentially volatile and emotions charged situations.
