Bylaw 06-22

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH AN ASSESSMENT APPEAL FEE

Subsection 224(1) of "The Municipalities Act" permits council to establish fees for the purposes of assessment appeals.

Subsection 224(4) of "The Municipalities Act" provides that where an appellant is successful in whole or in part, on an assessment or classification appeal at either the board of revision or the appeal board, the fee shall be refunded.

The council of the Resort Village of Bird's Point, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. An appeal fee of \$300.00 per assessment appeal is hereby established.
- 2. That upon successful completion of the appeal, in whole or in part, the appeal fee shall be refunded.
- 3. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on February 15, 2022.
- 4. Bylaw No. 08-10 is hereby repealed.
