This letter is to confirm that Lightship Security is under contract with KLC Group, LLC to perform a Common Criteria evaluation of various models of the KLC CipherDriveOne, version 2.0.1. The evaluation will be done against the collaborative Protection Profile (PP) for Full Drive Encryption (CPP_FDE_AA_V2.0E).

Lightship is targeting an initial submission to the Canadian Common Criteria Scheme (CCCS) by February 23, 2024 and estimates an “In-evaluation” listing in March 2024.
