RULES & GUIDELINES

GUARANTEED TWO GAMES

*****All games will be played according to MHSAA rules except where modified*****

- All 5th & 6th grade games will be played in four 8-minute running time quarters.
- All 3rd & 4th grade games will be played in four 8-minute running time quarters.
- All consolation games will have four 6-minute running quarters.
- Backcourt press will be allowed only in the last one minute of each half at which time the clock stops on all whistles.
- The clock runs during free throws other than the last minute of the half when the clock is stopping.
- Each team is allowed three (3), 1-minute time-outs per game.
- Overtime periods will be two (2) minutes long with the clock stopping every whistle.
- Each team will be allowed one (1), 1-minute time-out during each overtime period.
- Each game will have an official scorekeeper.
- **The championship game in each division will be single elimination.**
- Players may play up a grade, but not down. All teams are put in the division of the highest grade player(s).
- Games will be played as close to scheduled times as possible and will continue until completed. Be at your court 20 minutes prior to game time.
- Awards will be given to the winning teams and runner-up teams in each bracket and the consolation winners.
