Mrs. Serge, second by Mrs. Sullivan motioned to approve the current expenses. Motion carried with all in favor.

**Mayor Report:** Mayor Prince stated that while there are no laws currently in effect for e-bikes/scooters, he encourages residents to be safe and pay attention as the number of riders are increasing. He also reminded residents to be aware of school buses and wait for the children to get off the bus. There are some drivers who are not obeying the law around school buses.

**Solicitor Report:** Attorney Levine had nothing to report at this time.

# Committee Reports & Unfinished Business:

Mr. Carachilo noted that he had shared some paperwork regarding a number of grant opportunities with the Secretary. One of the applications is for a recreation grant that will not open again until early 2026. We are already working on the Local Share Account (LSA-gaming) fund grant.

A school bus driver contacted Council about having the ability to back up on Ash & Fifth in order to avoid having to drive through Richmondale and turn around. Carbondale PD said there was nothing illegal about that and the driver was notified that she is allowed to do that.

Mr. Pantzar reported that there were two applicants for part-time help in the street department. They interviewed Sam Yankauskas has prior experience working for the Forest City Borough street department. Mr. Pantzar made a motion, second by Mr. Matos to hire Mr. Yankauskas at \$18/hour.

After discussion and review of the bids, Mr. Pantzar made a motion to accept the bid from Casella for weekly trash and recycling collection. Mr. Matos seconded the motion which carried with all in favor. It was noted that sometimes there is an issue with bulk items. Casella representatives stated that they automatically run a truck every week.

Council discussed upcoming grant opportunities that they would like to apply for recreation improvements including playground equipment and mulch. Colleen and Amanda will review options and obtain a cost estimate that would include fence repair. Council approved resolutions to apply for LSA and Lackawanna County grant funds for this project.

Mark Cordelli representing Lackawanna County provided flyers and a list of upcoming events throughout the County.

The meeting adjourned at 8 PM on a motion by Mr. Carachilo, second by Mr. Pantzar. All in favor.
