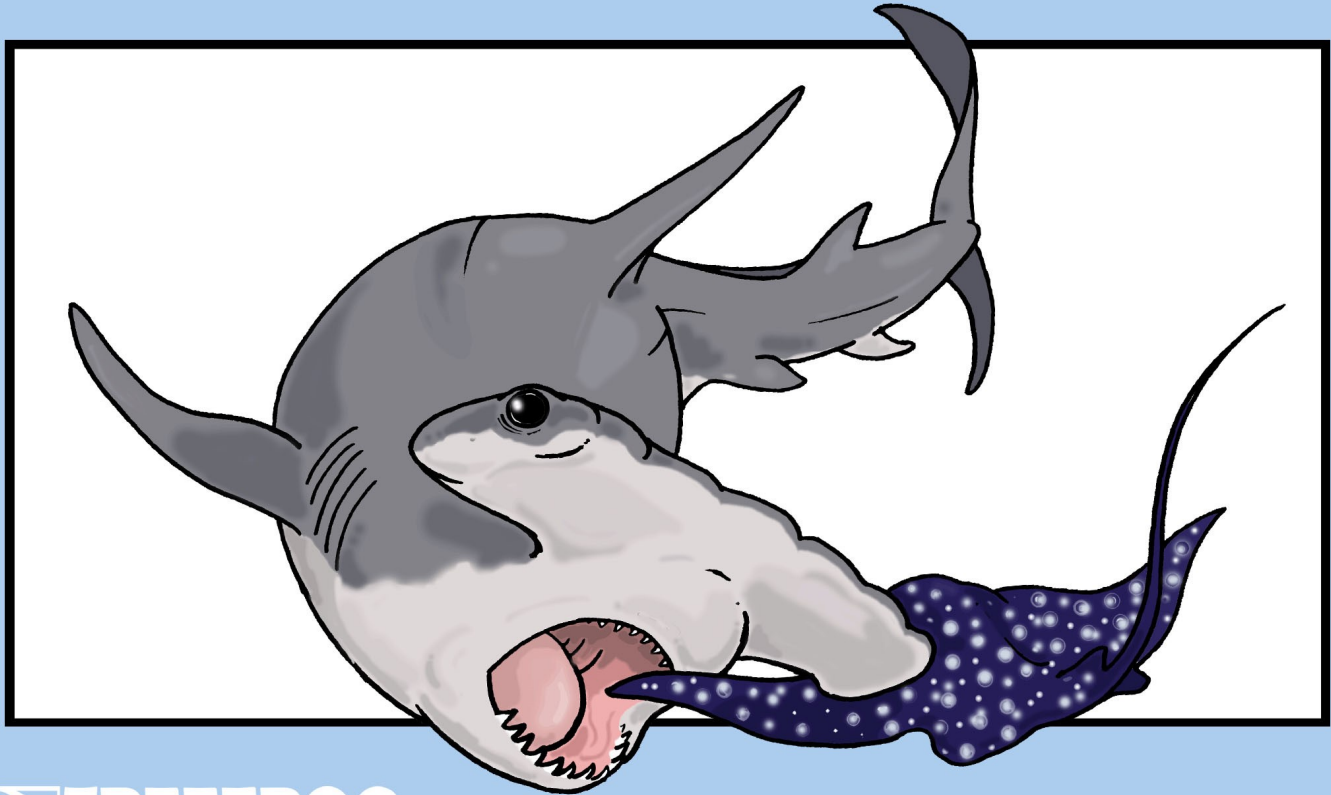
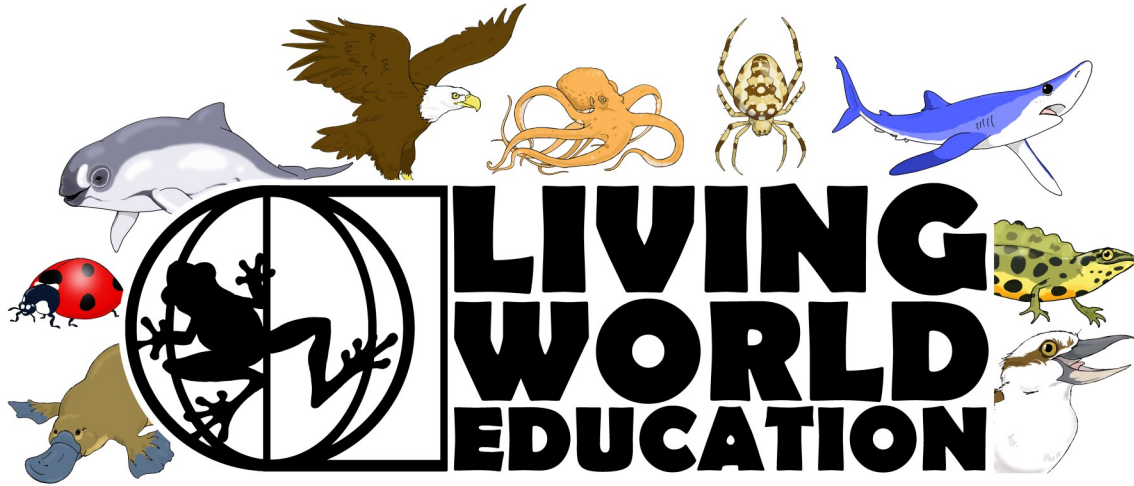

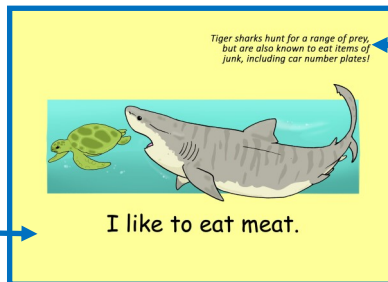

## BEFORE YOU START...

The child reads the big, bold type.  
This contains the most common words, words that can be decoded or words containing the sound being learnt.



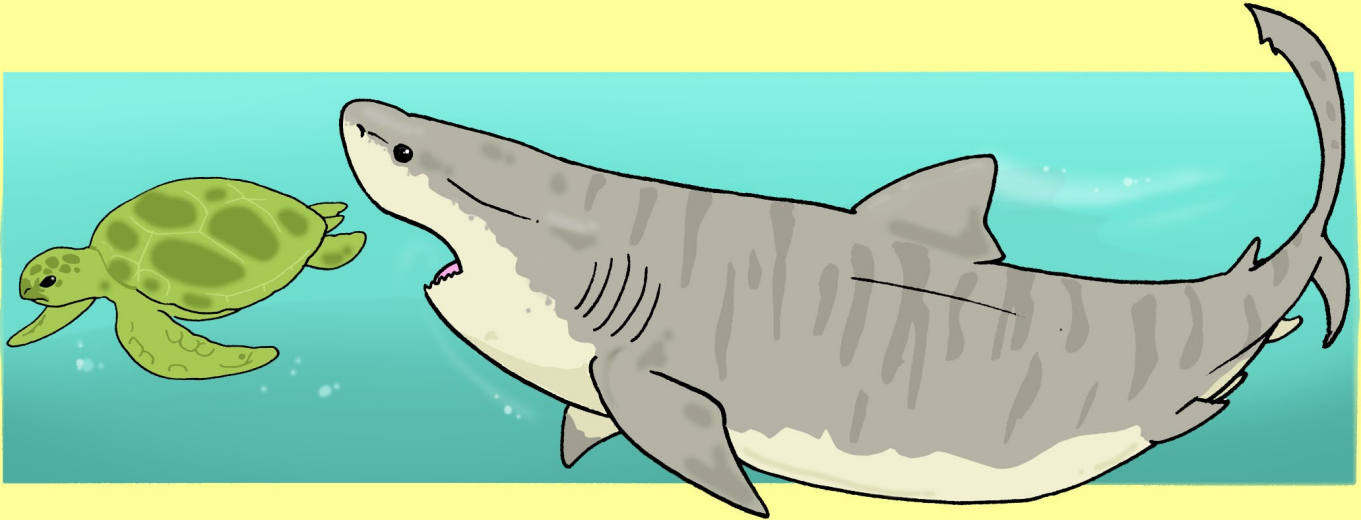
The text in the corner is just for the adult or reading partner. This is to develop the child's vocabulary and promote discussion.

junk, including car number plates!*



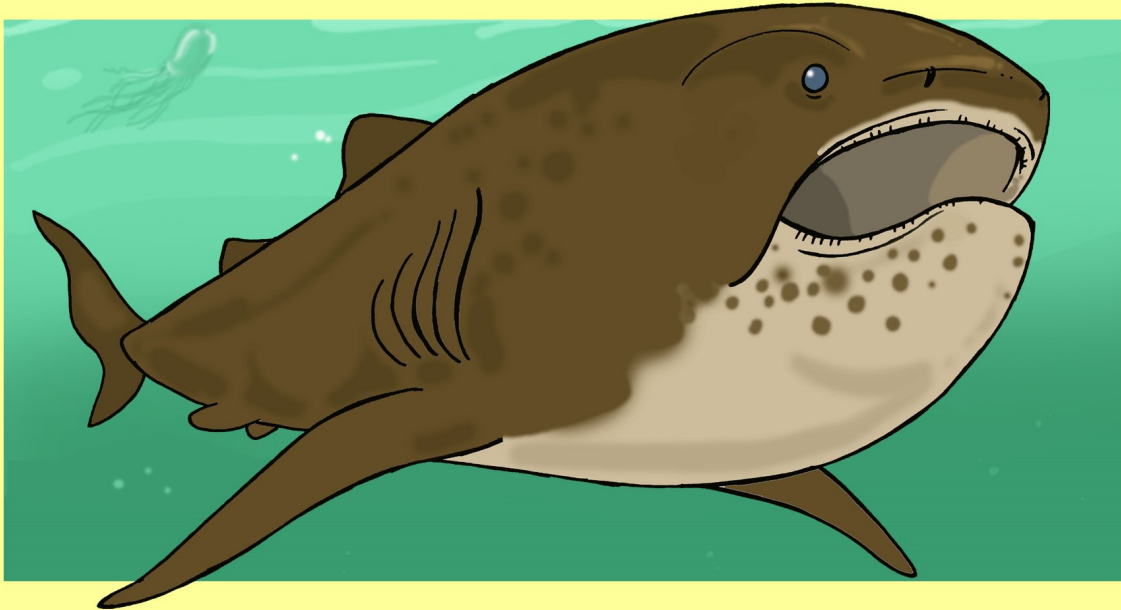
I like to feast on meat.

hidden on the seabed.*



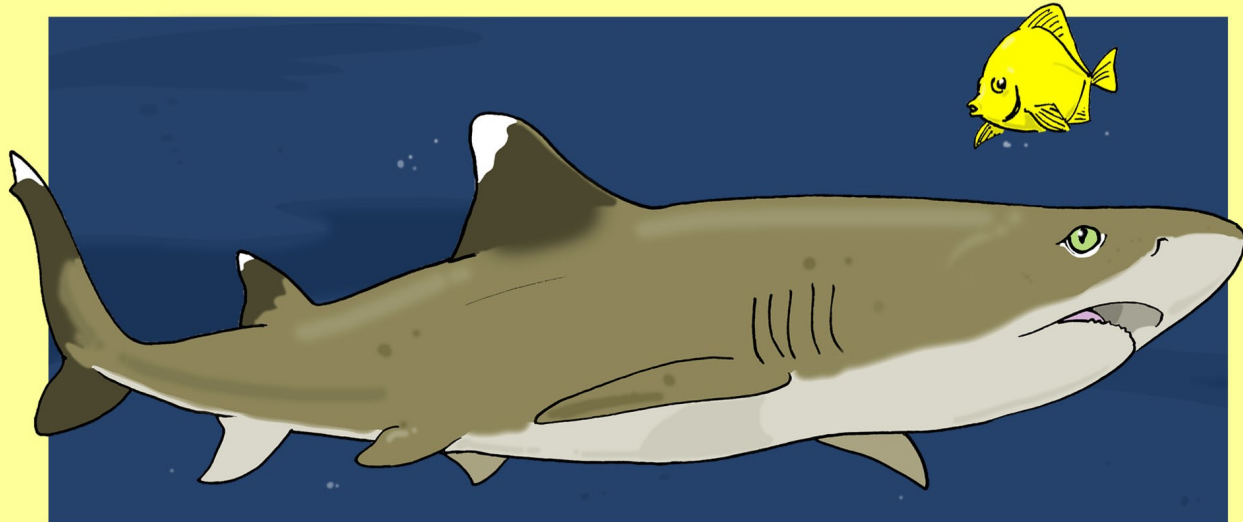
I dig in the sand for my meal.

*This whitetip reef shark, stops the disease spreading by eating any weak or injured fish.*



I hunt and eat the weak.

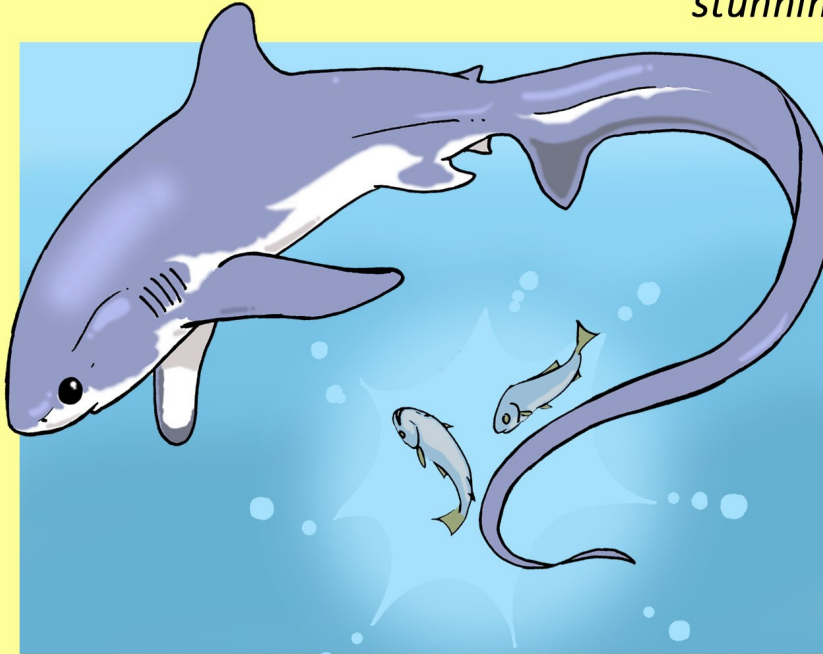
*Wobbegong sharks use their elaborate camouflage to stay hidden and ambush prey as it passes by.*

*Thresher sharks have incredibly long tails. This tail is used like a whip, stunning their fish prey.*



**I slap my long fin to get a meal.**

*Great hammerheads come into shallow waters to hunt stingrays. They use their wide head to pin down prey.*



I can hunt next to the beach.

*Spy-hopping is used by great whites to look for signs of seals and sea lions above the surface.*



I can sneak up near the beach.

*Great white sharks can leap out of the water in pursuit of seal prey. This is called a breach.*



**I leap to eat a seal.**

*Striped pilot fish help this oceanic whitetip shark by eating pests that live on her rough skin.*



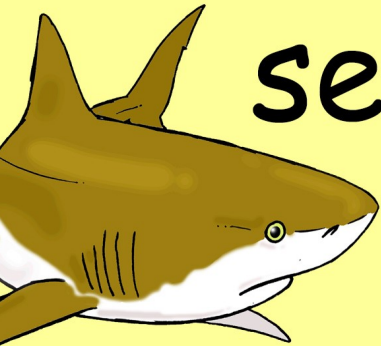
A team helps me to get clean.
