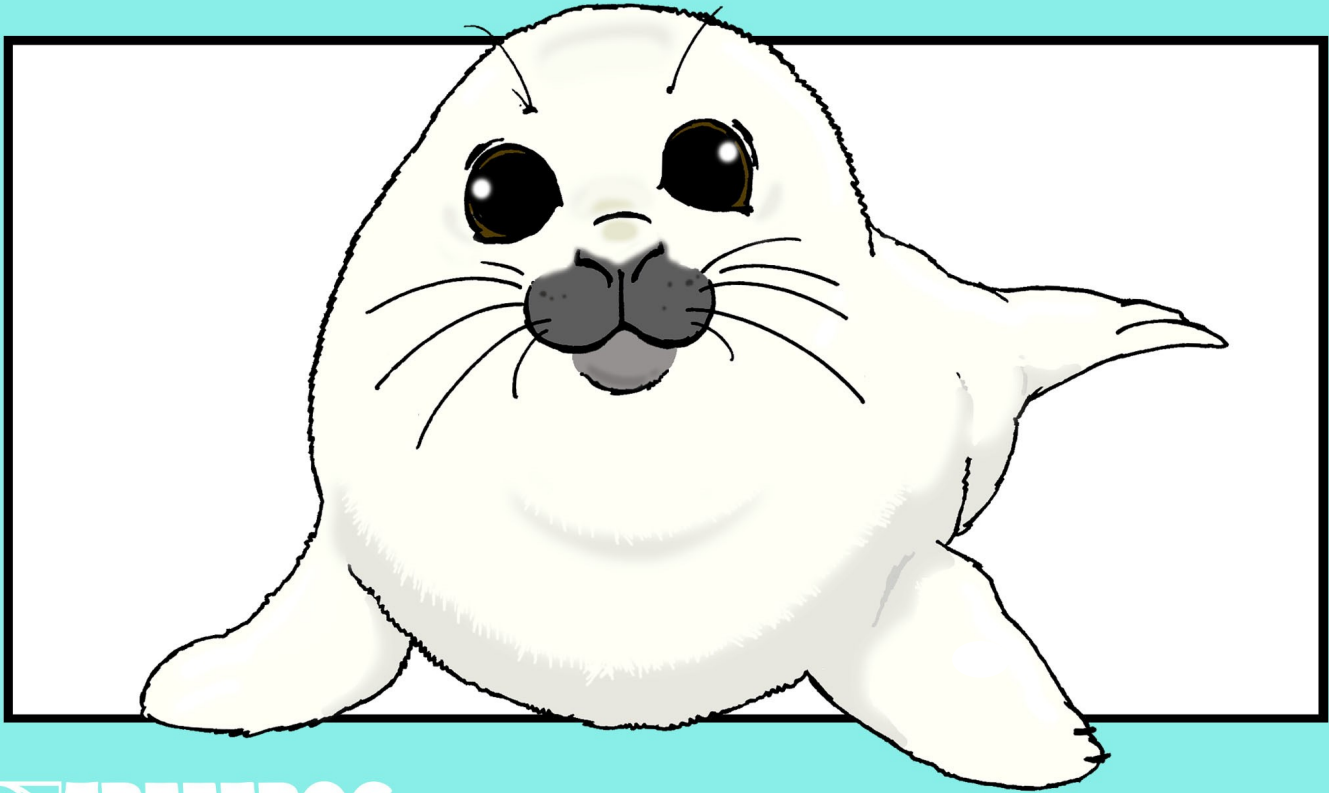
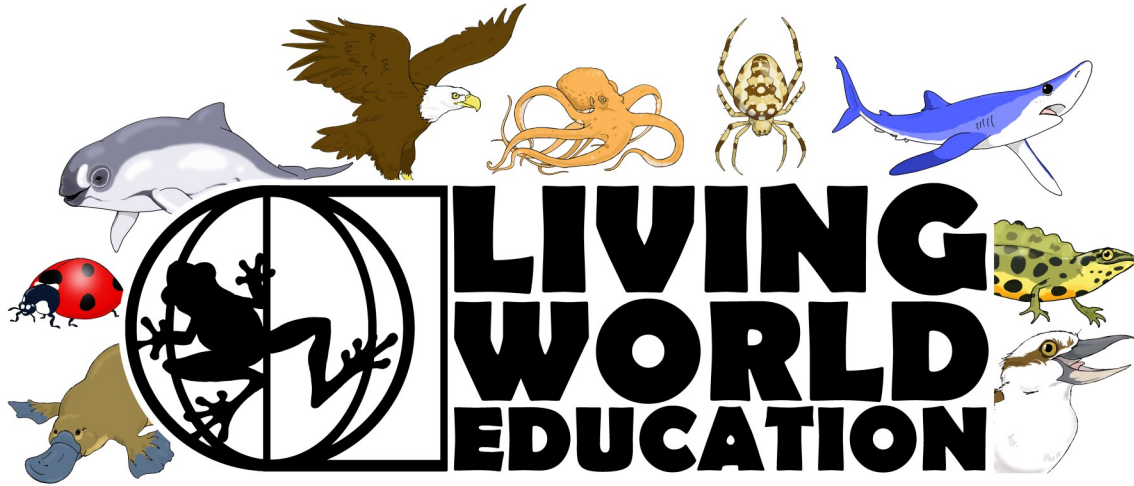

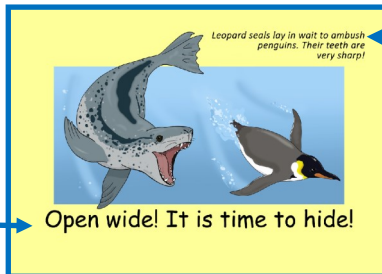

BEFORE YOU START...

The child reads the big, bold type. This contains the most common words, words that can be decoded or words containing the sound being learnt.



The text in the corner is just for the adult or reading partner. This is to develop the child's vocabulary and promote discussion.

Adelie penguin.*



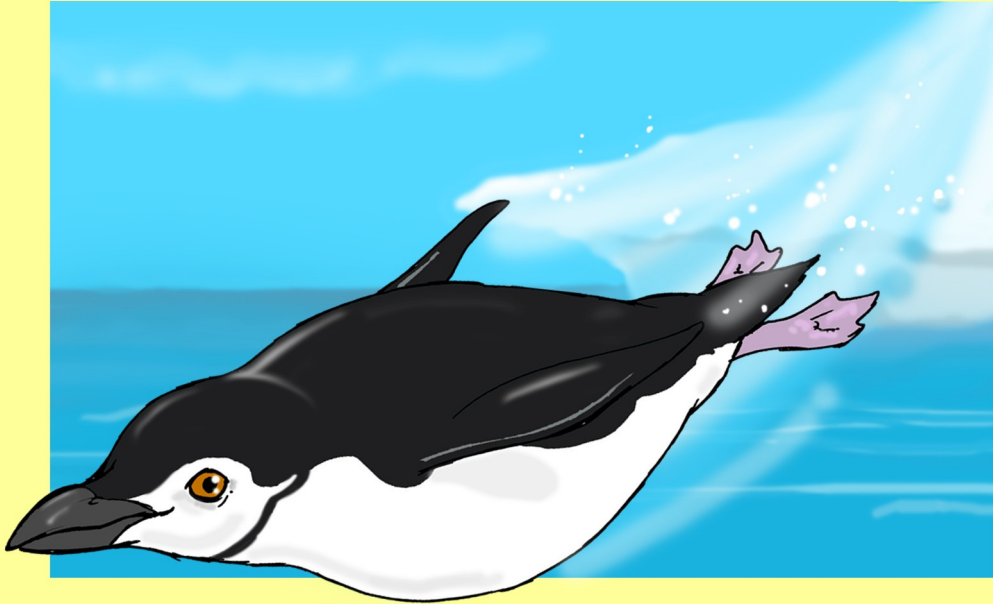
I like life on the ice.

display to other penguins.*



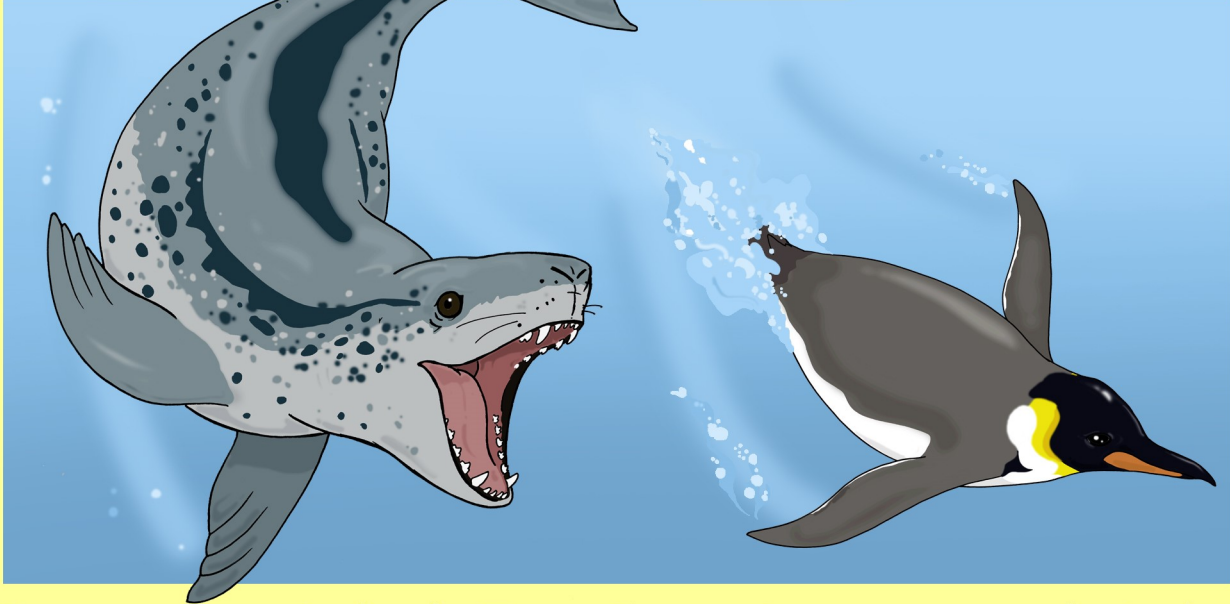
I like to stride with pride.

back to the ocean.*



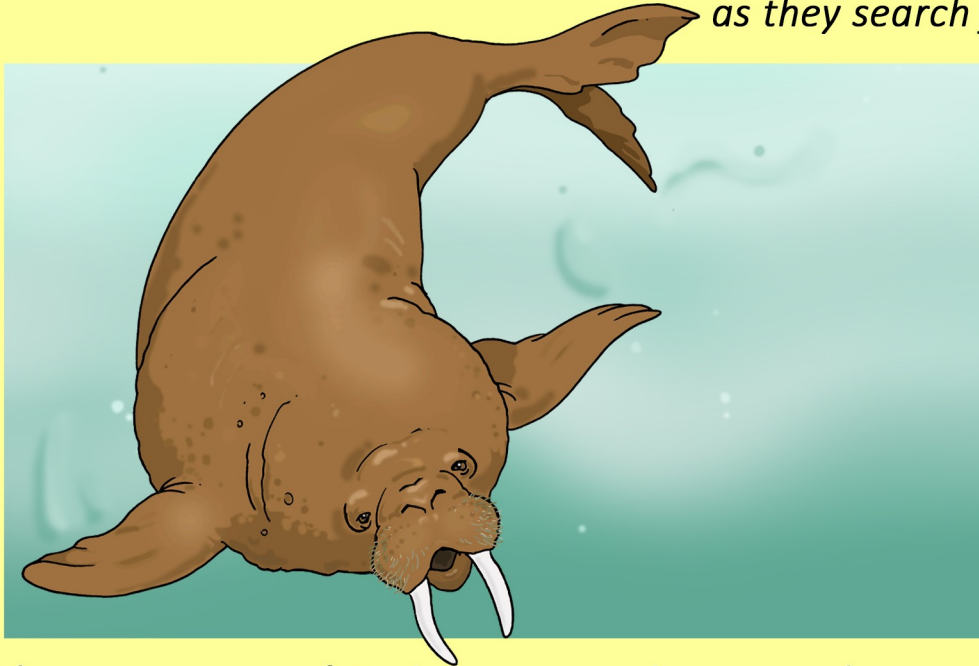
I slide on my tum, then dive in!

Musk oxen have thick fur that enables them to stay out even in wild Arctic storms!



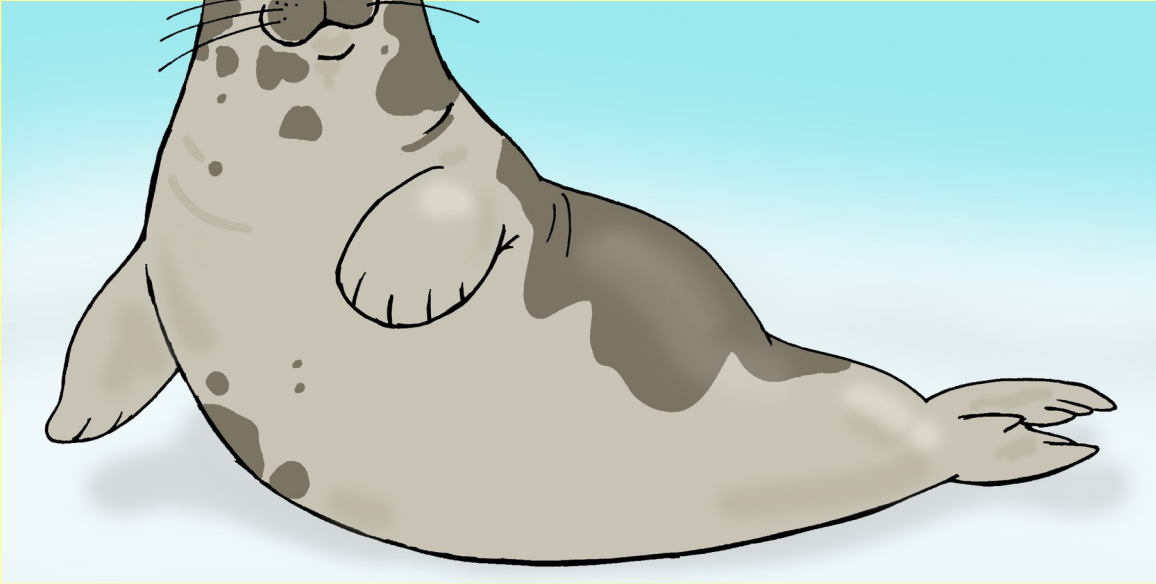
This musk ox wants to hide.

Seal pups, born on the ice, must be camouflaged or they could be a meal for a polar bear!



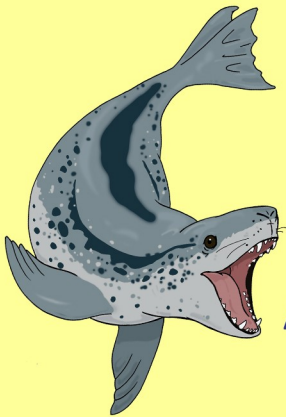
The pup is as white as ice.
