

### **BEFORE YOU START...**

The child reads the big, bold type.
This contains the most common words, words that can be decoded or words containing the sound being learnt.



\_\_\_ The text in the corner is just for the adult or reading partner. This is to develop the child's vocabulary and promote discussion.



Say "ar" (as in "dark").

Say it quiet, say it loud and say it silly! Trace the letters with your finger... Let's go!



Fox is in the den until dark.



Fox has not fed. Where to start?

Clever urban foxes can quickly become familiar with areas humans use, such as parks.



Fox can trot to the park.

Foxes are curious creatures, sniffing out any potential sources of food.



It is dark in the park.

Hedgehogs might make a good meal, but in most cases, foxes are deterd by their painful spikes.

Because there is so much food in towns, urban foxes grow bigger than those in countryside areas.

Foxes will happily move between towns and their natural habitat, the countryside.

The farm is dark.


