
A Day in The Bay

BEFORE YOU START...

The child reads the big, bold type.
This contains the most common words, words that can be decoded or words containing the sound being learnt.




<u>just for the adult or reading</u>

The fur of sea otters keeps them warm as they swim down, searching for spiky urchins to eat.




We play all day in the bay.

Sea otters break open food on rocks placed on their tummies on the waters surface.




I lay back. My tum is a tray.

Anemones have tentacles that collect microscopic food from the water.




I stay still and sway.

Moray eels show their powerful jaws to warn off unwanted attention.




The moray says stay away!

A bottlenose dolphin calf needs lots of care, as there are many dangers in the ocean.




Do not stray away from mum.
