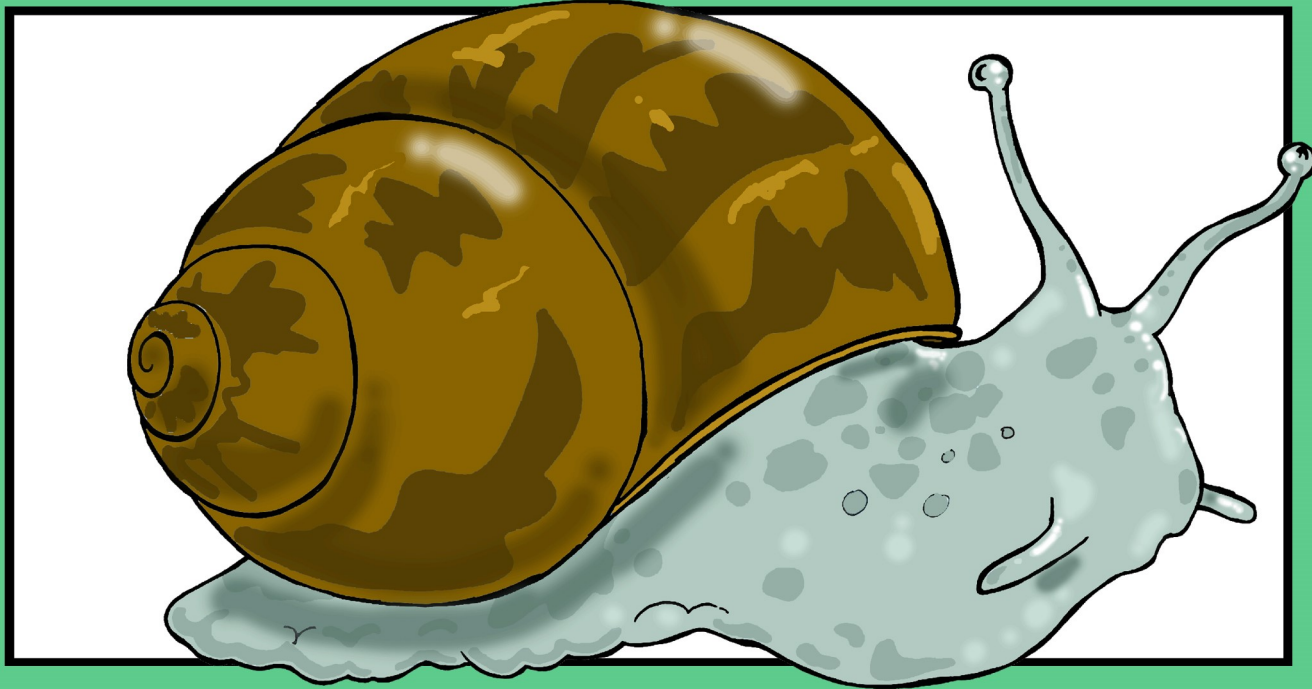


Snails, Slugs and Bugs

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BEFORE YOU START...

The child reads the big, bold type. This contains the most common words, words that can be decoded or words containing the sound being learnt.



The text in the corner is just for the adult or reading partner. This is to develop the child's vocabulary and promote discussion.

Say "ai" (as in "snail").

Say it **quiet**, say it **loud** and say it **silly**! Trace the letters with your finger... **Let's go!**

Snails have soft bodies that need to stay moist, so they are very active in wet weather.



The snail likes it in the rain.

Some snails, like these pond snails, live all their lives in water. Can you see how their shells look different?



These snails are pond snails.

Slugs, like snails, leave a trail of slime behind them as they crawl along.



This slug laid a long trail.

Garden spiders construct webs from strong, sticky silk. The web traps the spider's prey.



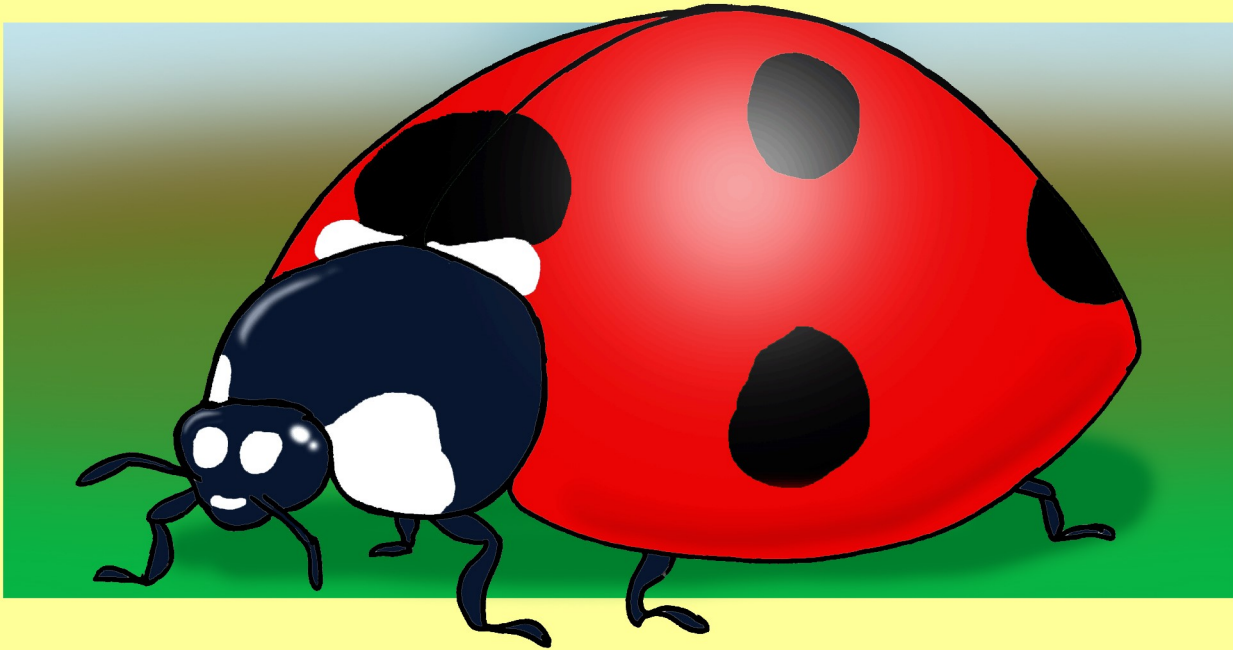
I will wait and wait in my web.

Earthworms are so important in helping the soil stay healthy. They are also food for many other animals.



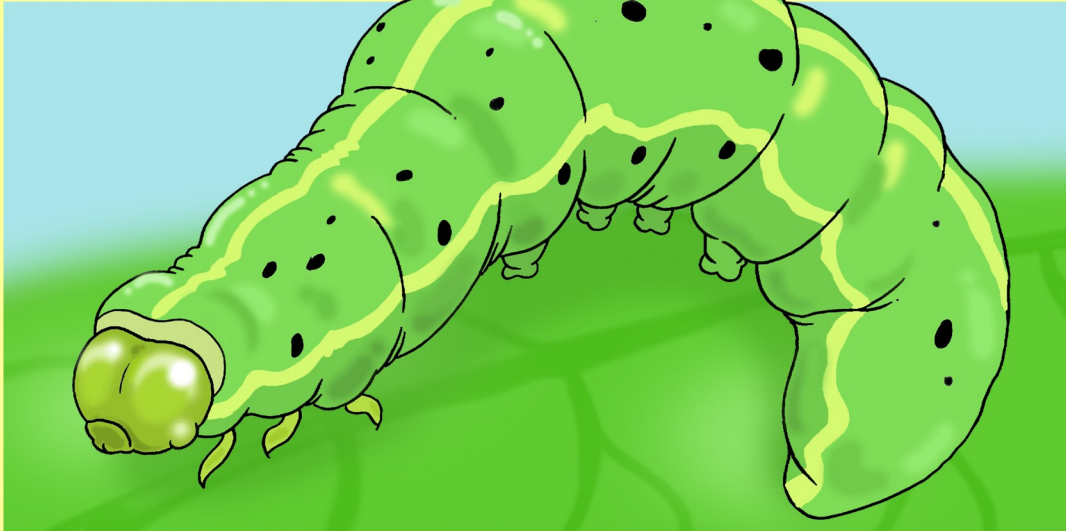
Mud contains lots of these!

The spots look like a pair of big eyes!*



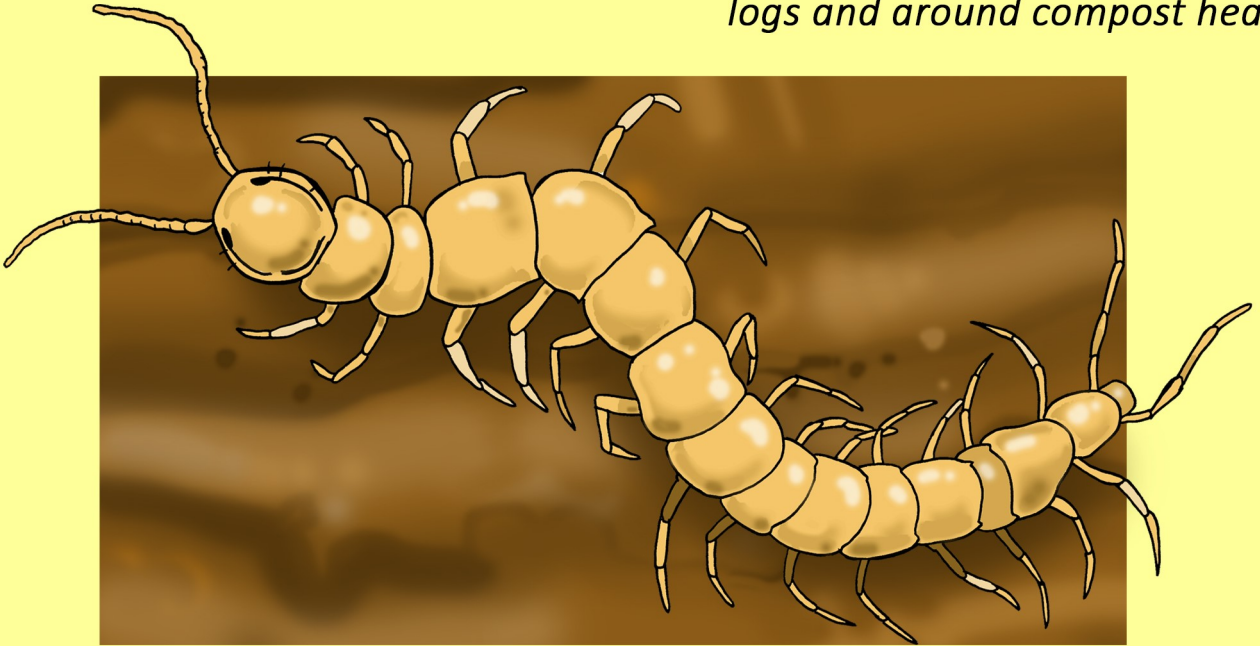
The wings look like spots of paint.
