#### **BEFORE YOU START...**

The child reads the big, bold type. This contains the most common words, words that can be decoded or words containing the sound being learnt.




The text in the corner is just for the adult or reading partner. This is to develop the child's vocabulary and promote discussion.

Spyhopping is used by great whites to spot where prey, like seals or sea lions, may be around.




### This shark can look at the beach.




### A shark leaps. It wants to eat a seal.

Bronze whaler sharks scare fish into bait balls making them easier to catch.




### Sharks can help to trap a feast.

Tiger sharks like a wide range of prey, but are also known to eat junk items including car number plates!




## Sharks like to eat meat.

#### Great hammerheads use their wide head to pin down stingray prey.




### This shark can hunt for a meal.
