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BEFORE YOU START...

The child reads the big, bold type.
This contains the most common words, words that can be decoded or words containing the sound being learnt.



___ The text in the corner is just for the adult or reading partner. This is to develop the child's vocabulary and promote discussion.

A cow fed on grass and flowers.




Wow! It drops down for a fish.

Racoons are very at home in water and can find creatures to eat amongst the rocks of the riverbed.




He will not drown in this shower.

The great horned owl has elaborate feathers above it's eyes that give it a fearsome appearance.




The owl scowls down.
