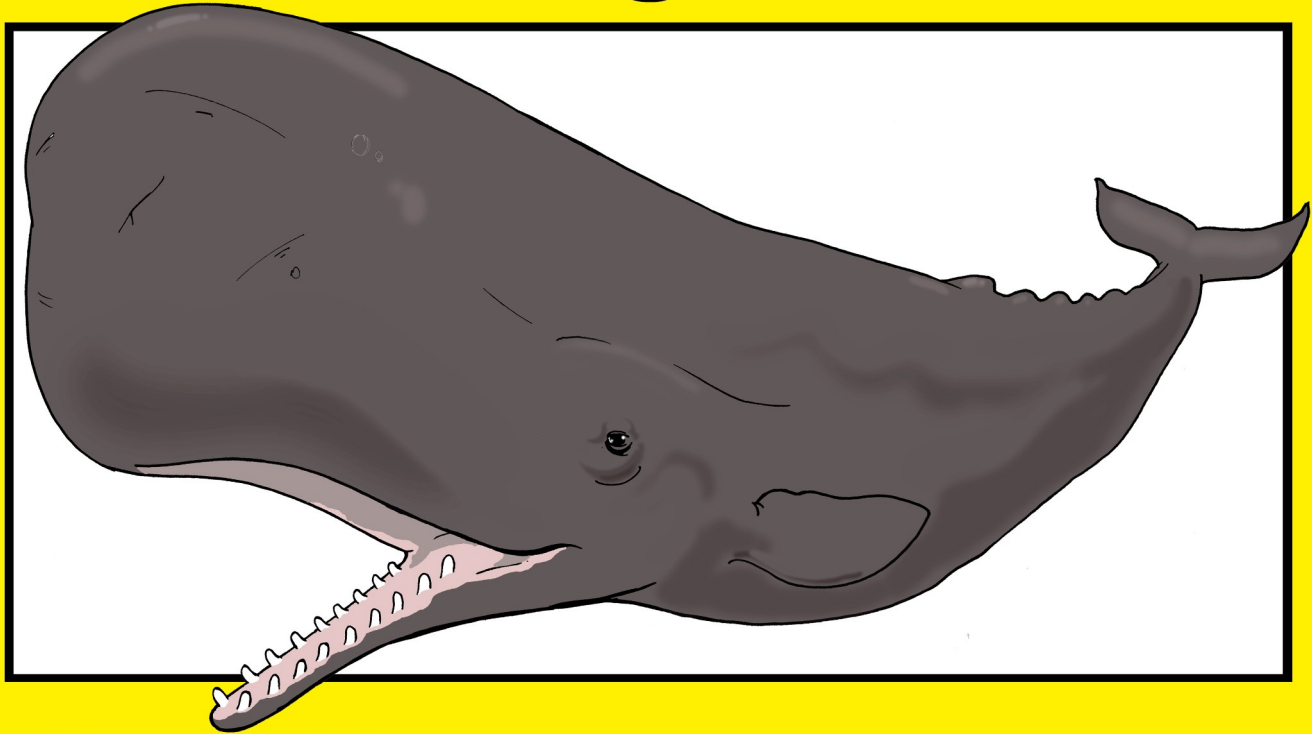


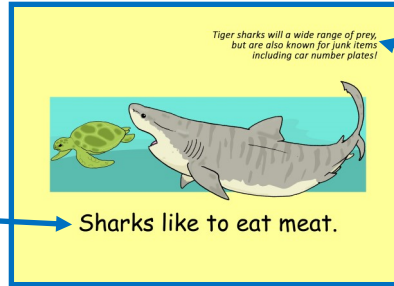
# The Big Show

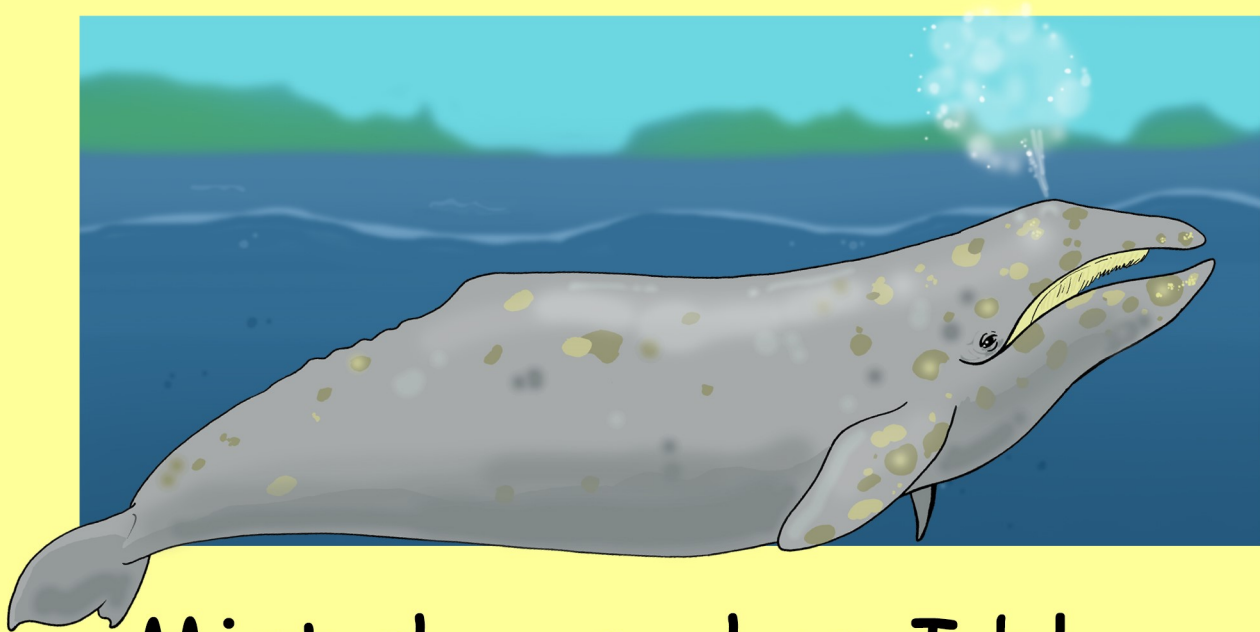

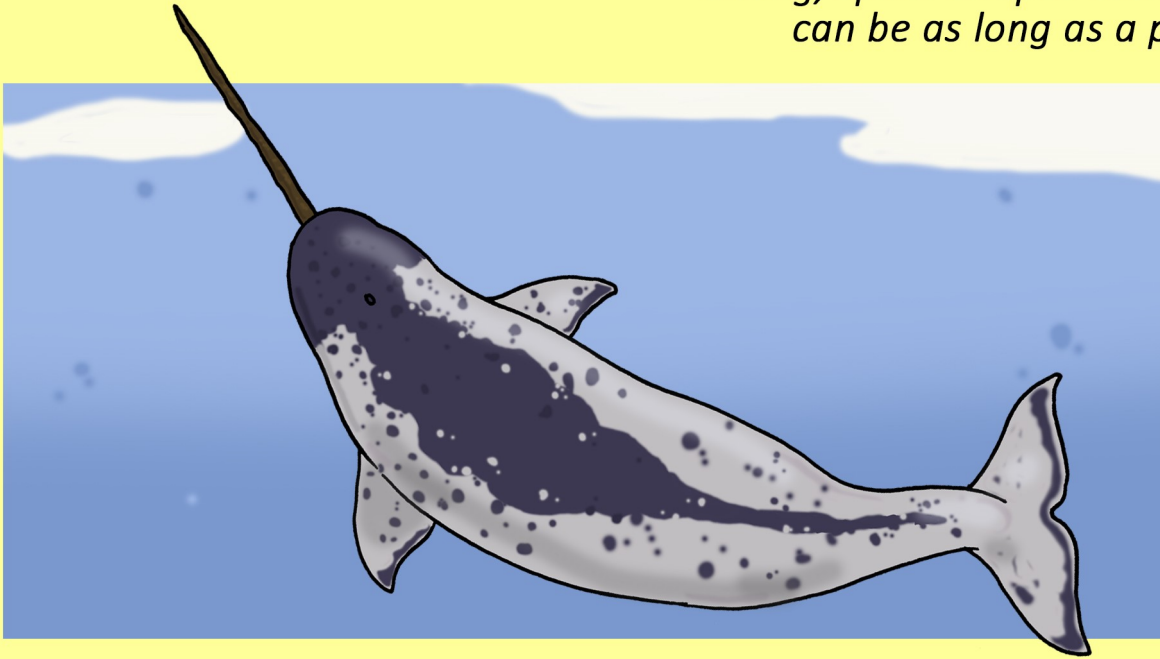

occurs when they breathe out.*



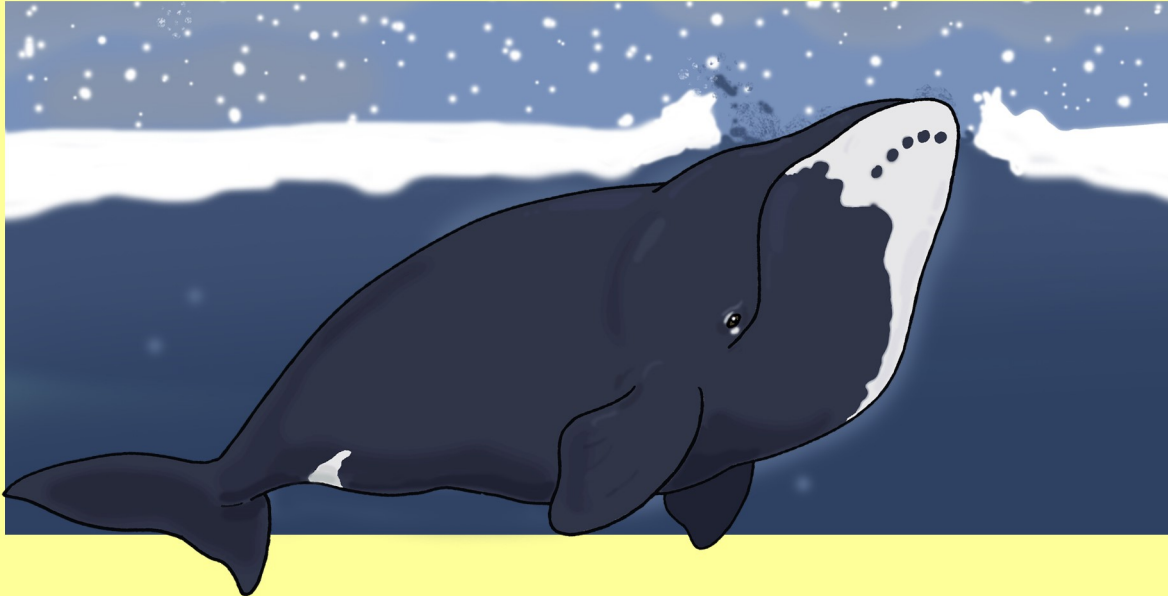
Mist shows when I blow.

can be as long as a person!*



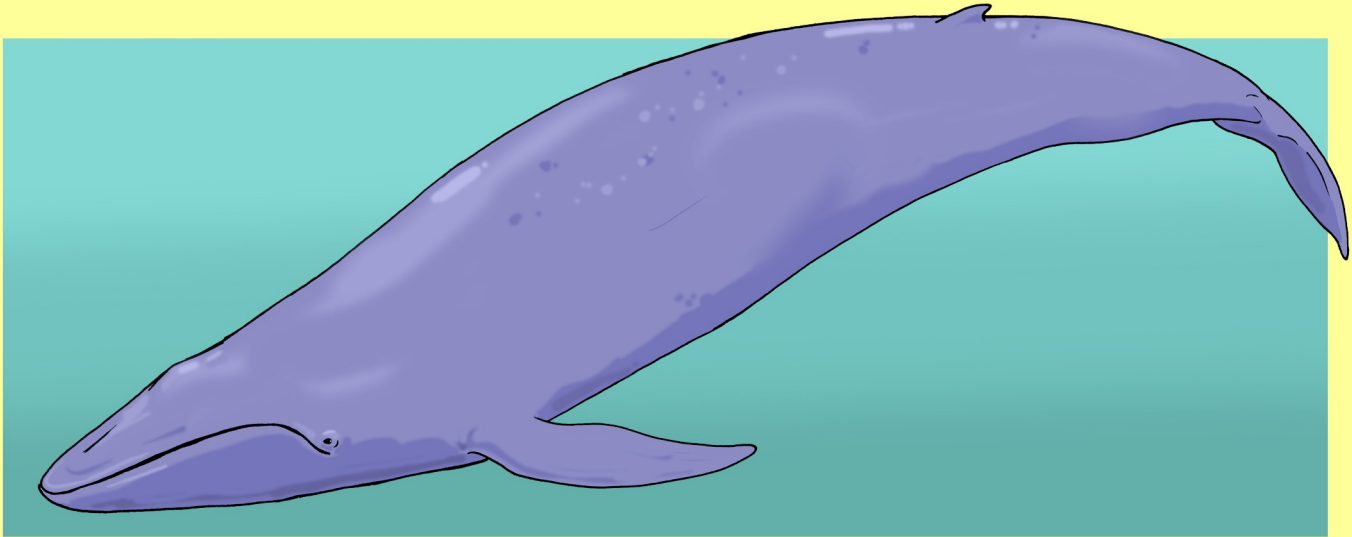
I own a long tusk.

the ice so it can breathe.*



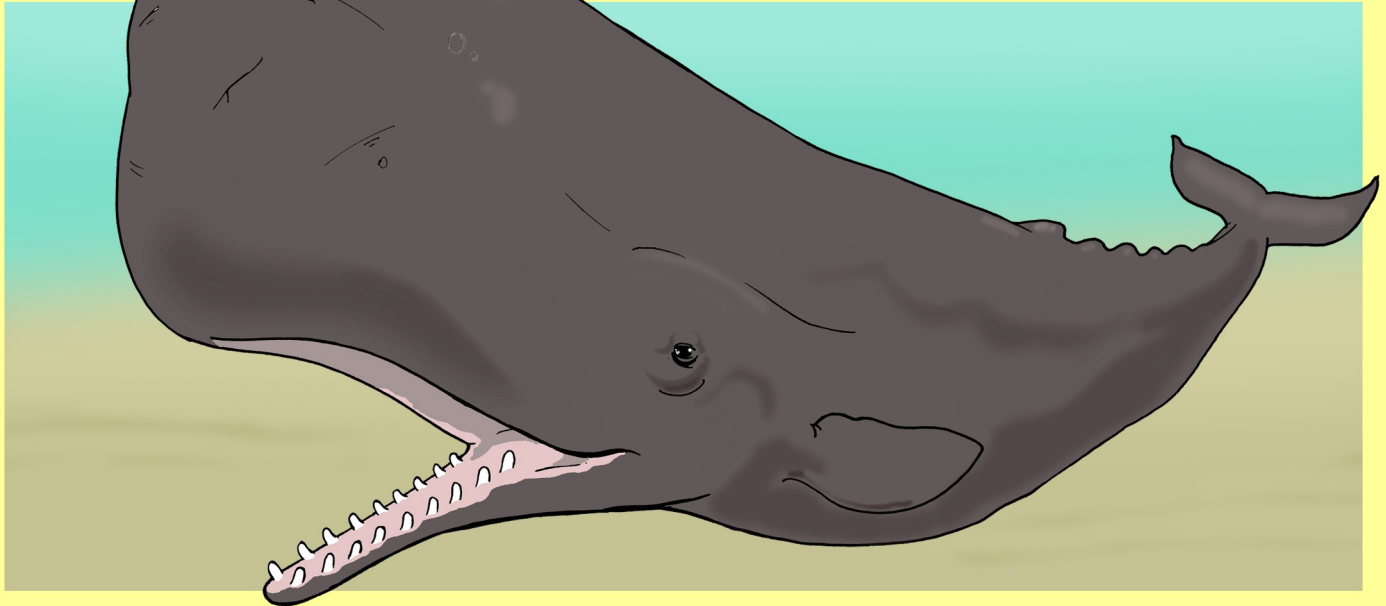
I lift up a window in the snow.

I will grow to be the biggest.

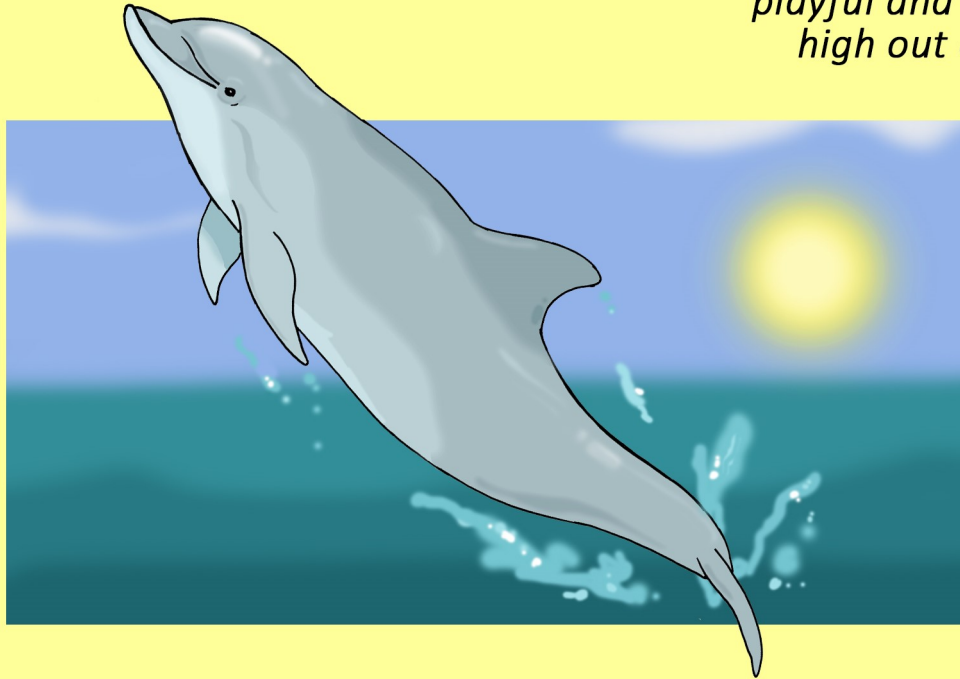
*Despite diving deep into the ocean to

**I rest in the shallows.**

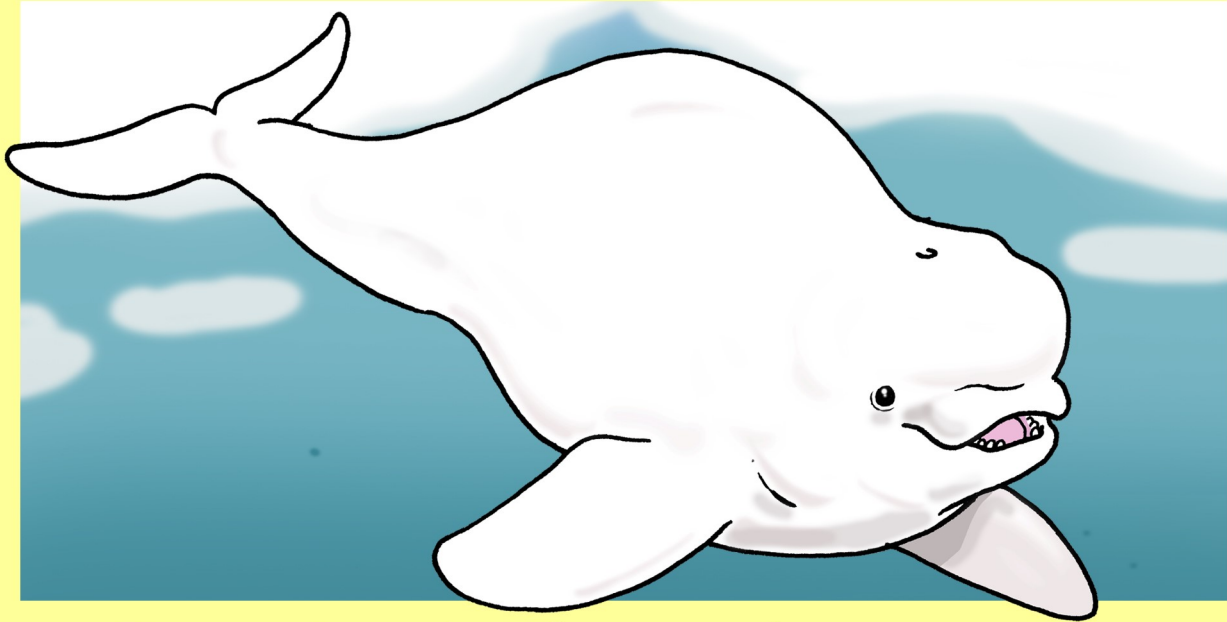


*Bottlenose dolphins are very

high out of the water.*



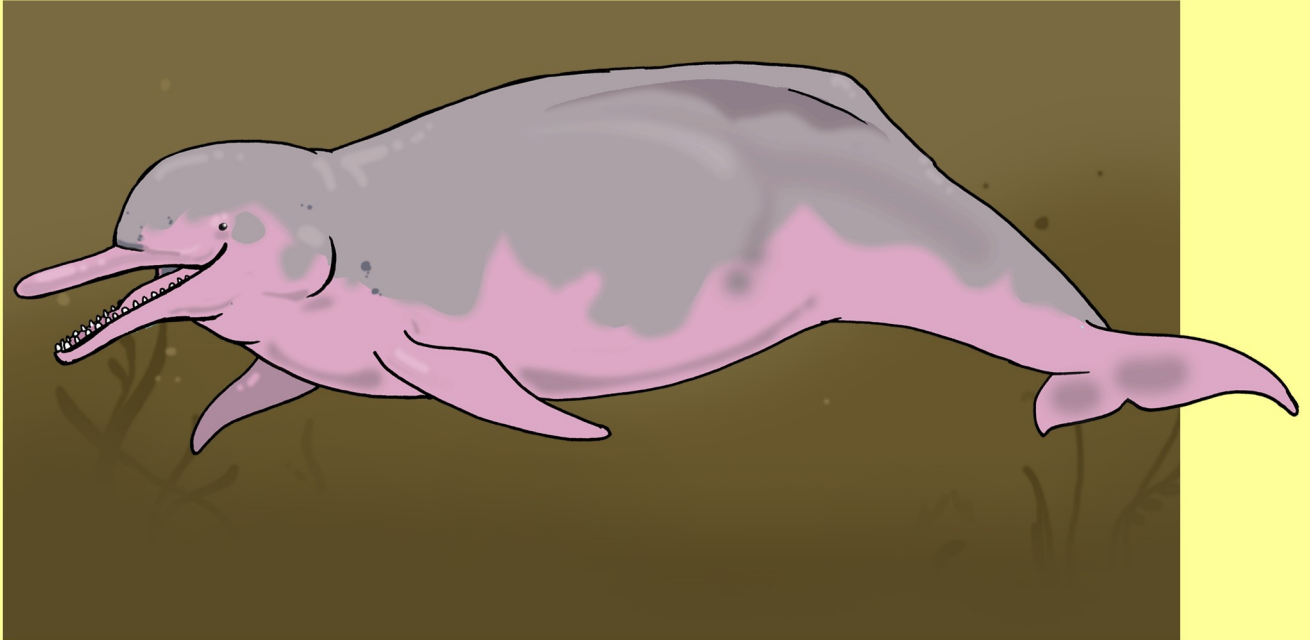
**I will show you I can jump!**

**I follow the flow.**

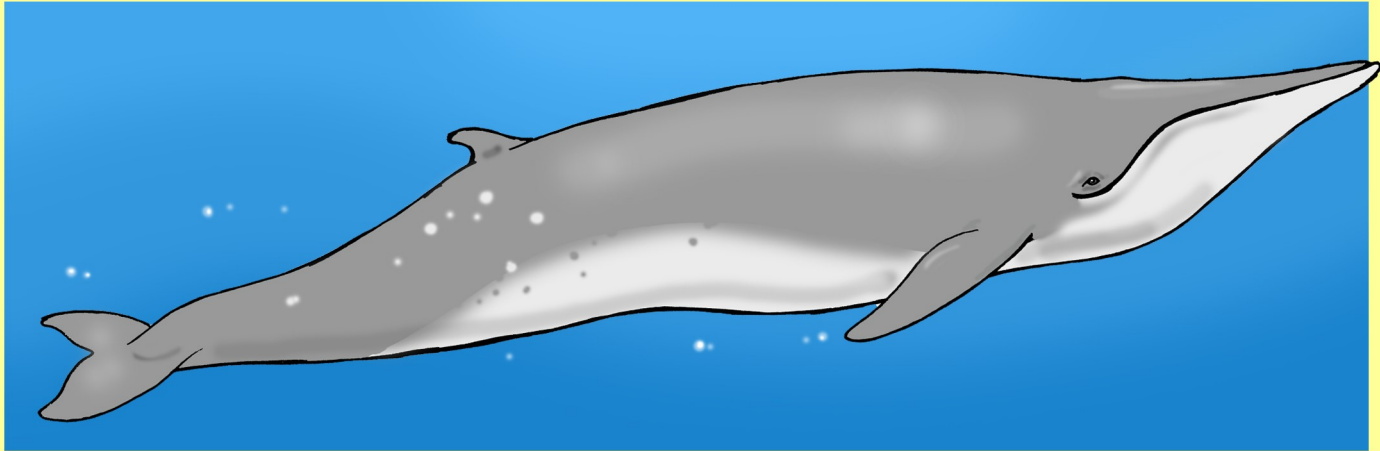


*Krill form huge swarms and whales

streamlined body shape.*



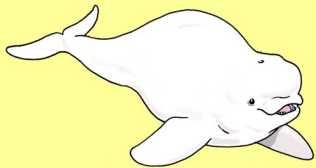
I swim fast. You can not follow me!
