

The Big Show

The text in the corner is <u>just</u> <u>for the adult to read</u>. This is to develop the child's vocabulary and to promote discussion.

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
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Whales can be seen from far away because of they misty spray that occurs when they breathe out.

The extraordinary looking narwal has a long, spiral-shaped tusk which can be as long as a person!




I own a long tusk.

The bowhead whale uses its large, blunt head to break holes in the ice so it can breathe.




I lift up a window in the snow.


Blue whales are the largest animal to have ever existed. They can be longer than three buses!



I will grow to be the biggest.




I rest in the shallows.




I will show you I can jump!

Boto are river dolphins that live in the murky waters of the Amazon.




I follow the flow.
