



BEFORE YOU START...

The child reads the big, bold type.

Say it quiet, say it loud and say it silly! Trace the letters with your finger... Let's go!




I like life on the ice.


Chinstrap penguins use their tummies like a sledge to move across the ice, before diving back to the ocean.

Open wide! It is time to hide!


Walruses are clumsy on land, but glide with great agility in the chilly water as they search for shellfish.




