





BEFORE YOU START...

The child reads the big, bold type.
This contains the most common words, words that can be decoded or words containing the sound being learnt.

Predatory crocodiles will slowly approach thirsty prey animals visiting the waterhole.




Will the croc soon spell doom?

Look at my big tooth!




A baboon jumps up on the roof.


The lion cubs need to wait for mum to go hunting.

Soon, they will get some food.




My hoof can boot you!


