

This contains the most common words, words that can be decoded or words containing the sound being learnt.




___ The text in the corner is just for the adult or reading partner. This is to develop the child's vocabulary and promote discussion.



Say "ow" (as in "grow").


Say it quiet, say it loud and say it silly! Trace the letters with your finger... Let's go!

Blue whales are the largest animal to have ever existed on our planet. They can be longer than three buses!




I will grow to be the biggest.

I rest in the shallows.




I can swallow lots of krill.

The long tusks of narwhals have given them the name of the "unicorns of the sea!"




I own a long tusk.


