Say "ow" (as in "howl").


Say it quiet, say it loud and say it silly! Trace the letters with your finger... Let's go!



It fed on grass and flowers.




Wow! What a lot of fowl.




I am big and brown.

Cougars can jump over remarkable distances to catch their prey. Their long tails help them to balance.




This big cat is on the prowl.
