



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#### **BEFORE YOU START...**

The child reads the big, bold type.
This contains the most common words, words that can be decoded or words containing the sound being learnt.

Whilst fur seals are incredible swimmers, they haul out on beaches to rest and to raise their young.




### My fur gets wet in the surf.

Land iquanas eat spiky cactus plants, despite the sharp spines covering them.


### This will not hurt me! Burp!

Using its protective shell, the reptile can escape unhurt.




A turtle turns. It is not hurt.




