Take a small ball of **air-dry** clay and cocktail sticks.

Add some ears!

Mould the clay to a tear drop shape.

Break off the ends of **cocktail sticks** and push them in to **cover the body**. Allow the clay to **dry** for a couple of days.



Paint and add on a nose and eyes. You now have your own hedgehog desk friend!
