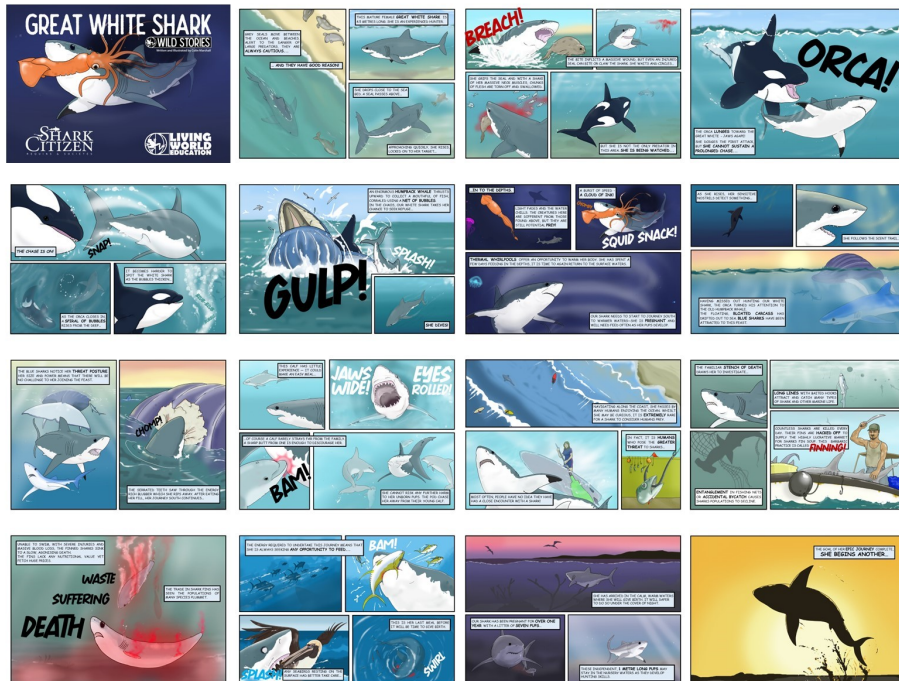
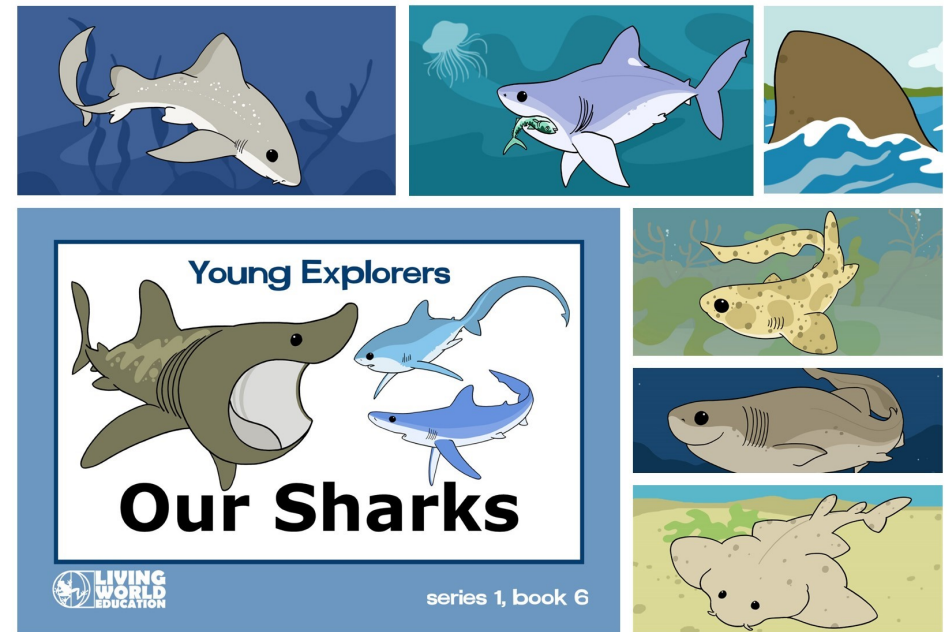


Week Five: Are there sharks in our seas?

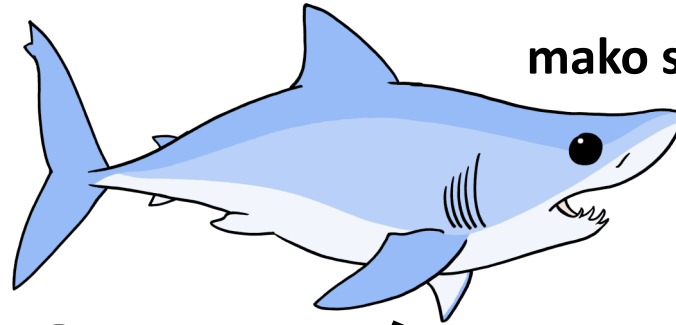
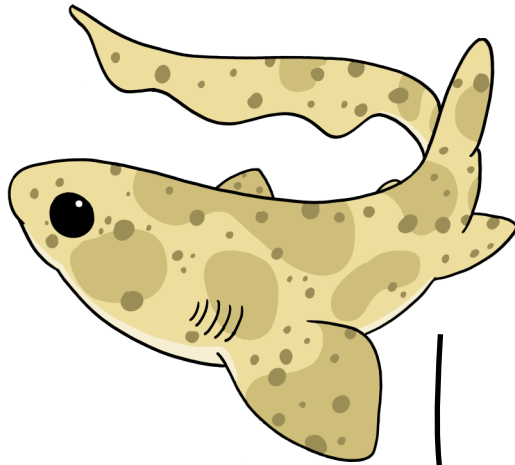
- Sharks face incredible dangers around the world. It is so vital that human behaviour changes so that their ever declining populations recover.
