Uniform

Jazz, Lyrical and Contemporary Classes

- Clean hair pulled off the face.
- Jazz shoes for Jazz (black or camel)
- Lyrical shoes, foot undies, bare feet, or half soles welcome for lyrical and contemporary.
- Voltage uniform or Blue, Purple, and Black. No baggy clothes

HIP HOP Classes

- Clean hair pulled off the face.
- Sneakers/ Street Shoes.
- Blue, Purple, or Black oversized clothing

ACROBATIC Classes

- Hair must be tight and pulled off the face.
- Acrobatic shoes (with grip) required for ALL acrobat's for safety.
- Level 3 and above must have proper jazz shoe with heel, with grip put on.
- Voltage Uniform (tight clothing) No stockings. No baggy Clothes

Trial Lessons

New and existing students are welcome to participate in a trial lesson during the first week of Term 1 and Term 2. Trial lessons are free during the first week; after this time, trial lessons will be charged at \$15 per class.

Enrolment in a technique class is compulsory for all Acrobatics and Jazz students. Technique classes are discounted by 50%.

If the technique class is taken on its own, the standard full price will apply.

Fees for solos, duos, and trios must be paid by the second lesson. Failure to do so will result in the student being unable to perform at competitions. Please note a \$50 deposit must be paid up front to the choreographer to secure your spot.

5% Discount is applied to class fees only when there are 2 or more siblings enrolled @Voltage Performing Arts.

Students attending four or more classes per week will receive 5% off their total fees.

Please note that the technique class, which is already discounted by 50%, does not count as an additional class.

Pricing for solos, duos, and trios is determined by the choreographer and their individual rates.



WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY

Release and Waiver of Liability

All clients agree to the following, with the company being Voltage Performing Arts and the instructors and our as-signed relief teachers, and you signed, as the client.

General

To the best of my knowledge, I am in suitable physical condition to participate in dance classes, lessons, workshops, performances, and events. I acknowledge that participation in dance and related physical activities involves inherent risks, including the risk of injury. I voluntarily choose to participate with an understanding of these risks and accept responsibility for my participation.

I agree that my participation is undertaken at my own risk and, to the extent permitted by law, I release and indemnify Voltage Performing Arts and its instructors from any claims, loss, damage, or injury arising out of or in connection with my participation in these activities.

I confirm that I assume the risk of, and the responsibility for any injury resulting from my participation in my activities. I participate in activities at my sole risk and responsibility and release, indemnify and hold harmless the instructor.

Pregnancy and Post-Partum

Participants who are pregnant or within six (6) months post-partum are strongly encouraged to seek medical clearance from their healthcare practitioner prior to participating in any classes, lessons, workshops, or events. By choosing to participate, I acknowledge and accept the inherent risks associated with physical activity during pregnancy or post-partum recovery. I agree that my participation is voluntary and at my own risk, and I release and indemnify Voltage Performing Arts and its instructors from liability for any injury or loss arising from my participation, to the extent permitted by law.

Alcohol and drug consumption

Alcohol and the use of illicit drugs are strictly prohibited before and during all classes, lessons, workshops, and events. Any participant who arrives at a class or event under the influence of alcohol or illicit drugs will not be permitted to participate and may be asked to leave the venue. Voltage Performing Arts and its instructors are not responsible for any injury, loss, or damage arising from a participant's decision to attend or participate while under the influence of alcohol or illicit drugs, to the extent permitted by law.



Health

I confirm that I have disclosed to the instructor any injury, illness, pregnancy, medical condition, or disability that may affect my ability to safely participate in activities. By signing this agreement, I acknowledge that I have read and understood this waiver and release of liability, and that I am signing it voluntarily of my own free will. I understand that no verbal statements or representations outside of this written agreement have been made, and I agree to be bound by its terms.

Photography

I, the undersigned participant and/or parent or legal guardian, grant permission for still and moving images of myself and/or my child, taken or recorded by or on behalf of Voltage Performing Arts, to be used for promotional, advertising, marketing, and related purposes. This may include use by Voltage Performing Arts and its partners, and may be shared with third parties such as media organisations, government bodies, and not-for-profit organisations.

Images may be used across various media formats, including but not limited to online platforms, social media, print, video, television, and other electronic or public display formats, and may be edited as required. I understand that no payment, royalties, or other compensation will be provided in connection with the use of these images.

If I wish to withdraw consent for future use of images, I will notify Voltage Performing Arts in writing. Withdrawal of consent will apply to future use only and does not affect materials already published or in circulation.

Damage to property

I, the undersigned participant and/or parent or legal guardian, accept financial responsibility for any damage to property caused by myself or my child through negligent or intentional actions while attending classes, workshops, rehearsals, or events held at venues hired by Voltage Performing Arts.



Voltage Performing Arts 2026 Terms and Conditions

Definitions

- **Parent/Guardian:** The person(s) over the age of 18 who is legally responsible for a student under 18 years of age, as nominated on the enrolment form.
- **Student:** The individual participating in classes, rehearsals, workshops, or events offered by Voltage Performing Arts.
- **Invoice Payee:** The person(s) financially responsible for all fees and any additional costs incurred throughout the year, including but not limited to uniforms, costumes, examinations, and competition fees.
- **Voltage Performing Arts:** The performing arts company providing the services and activities in which the student is enrolled.

By submitting an enrolment and/or attending classes with Voltage Performing Arts, you agree to the following Terms and Conditions:

1. Enrolment Duration

Enrolment is for the full calendar year. Once enrolled, students remain enrolled for each term of that year unless written notice of withdrawal is provided prior to the end of the current term (before the school holiday break between terms).

2. Invoicing & Payments

Invoices will be issued at the commencement of Terms 1, 2, 3, and 4. All fees must be paid by the stated due date. A late fee of \$25 may be applied to overdue accounts.

3. Non-Payment of Fees

Fees must be finalised by Week 5 of the term. If payment has not been received, the student's enrolment may be placed on hold, and the student will not be permitted to attend classes until the account is brought up to date.

4. Payment Plans

Parents, guardians, or invoice payees may request a payment extension or payment plan prior to the invoice due date. Approval of payment plans or extensions is at the discretion of Voltage Performing Arts.

5. Fees Inclusions

2026 fees include tuition and administrative costs associated with student enrolment, including licensing, administration, and public liability insurance. There is no additional enrolment or registration fee unless otherwise stated.

6. Enrolment Confirmation

No class places will be held without completed enrolment and payment. Enrolment is only confirmed once the enrolment form has been submitted and payment has been made.

7. Missed Classes

No refunds or credits are provided for classes missed due to illness, injury, holidays, or other personal circumstances. Please notify the studio of absences where possible. Extenuating circumstances may be considered at the discretion of Voltage Performing Arts.

8. Cancelled Classes

If a class is cancelled by Voltage Performing Arts, a make-up class, credit, or refund may be offered where appropriate.

9. Full Classes & Waitlists

If a class is full at the time of enrolment, families will be contacted to discuss alternative options or placed on a waitlist until a position becomes available.

10. Student Behaviour & Bullying

Voltage Performing Arts has a zero-tolerance policy for bullying. Any student who engages in bullying behaviour may have their enrolment terminated immediately.

11. Parent & Guardian Conduct

Voltage Performing Arts also enforces a zero-tolerance policy for bullying, harassment, or abusive behaviour from parents, guardians, emergency contacts, or invoice payees. This includes written or verbal threats, harassment, derogatory remarks, or defamatory statements directed toward staff, students, or affiliated persons. Breaches of this policy may result in immediate termination of the student's enrolment.

12. Allergies & Safety

Due to severe nut allergies within our community, nuts and nut products are strictly prohibited at all venues. Parents and guardians are responsible for ensuring that any required medication (e.g. EpiPens) is supplied and accessible for students with known allergies or medical conditions.

13. Compliance with Terms

Voltage Performing Arts is unable to provide refunds to families who enrol in classes but later determine that their circumstances do not align with these Terms and Conditions. Enrolment confirms acceptance of all policies outlined above.
