# - Grant Application Guidelines -



**Books for Bloomington-Normal Kids** puts new books in the hands and homes of children in need. Schools/organizations located in Bloomington-Normal, with a 70% low-income population, are awarded a grant to select books based on the children's interest. Educators are required to present lessons/activities with each book. The books become the property of the children, so they may begin to build a home library and develop a positive connection with reading as a family.

# **Eligibility Requirements:**

- Schools/Organizations/Programs based in Bloomington-Normal, Illinois
- Serve programs where at least 70% of the children come from low-income families or are a Title I or Title I eligible school.
- Serve children ranging in age from birth up to age 18.
- Nondiscrimination on the basis of race, gender, sexual orientation, national origin, religion or physical or mental disability.
- Fully complete the grant application.
- Follow the guidelines listed below.

# Guidelines – Requirements for organizations applying for a grant from *Books for BN Kids*:

- Grant requests are limited to \$5,000.
- Once the books are received, educators/directors present lessons/activities with the reading of each book purchased.
- Although this is not a requirement, we encourage involvement of the children's family in activities to develop a positive connection with reading as a family.
- Ensure the books become the property of the children, so they may begin to build a home library.
- Grant recipients may only use the grant funds for book purchases and not for other non-book items.
- Books must be ordered within six months of receiving the grant money.
- Submit receipts for books purchased with the awarded grant money. Email receipts to: **BooksForBloomingtonNormalKids@gmail.com**
- Grantees that do not follow guidelines will lose funding and will not be considered for future grants for five years.

### How to submit grant application – Two options: Email application or Google Docs

- Email the completed grant as an attachment to: **BooksForBloomingtonNormalKids@gmail.com**
- Complete the grant using the online form and submit through Google Docs.
- Grant applicants will receive an email confirmation within 48 hours.
- The grant proposal will be reviewed by **Books for BN Kids** Board of Directors.

### How to order books

- Grant winners will be notified by the end of October via e-mail.
- On behalf of *Books for BN Kids*, Illinois Prairie Community Foundation will distribute a check in order to purchase books.
- Teachers/Program Directors select books and place the order with awarded funds.

## Where to purchase new books with grant money

Books are 50-90% off retail prices. A First Book identification number is needed to place a book order.
