🄀 JESUS: THE SAVIOR WHO CAME FOR YOU

Let's make this personal.

Jesus didn't die for "people in general."

He died for you.

He didn't love "the world in a broad sense."

He loved you—by name, by heart, by purpose.

Before you ever believed, before you ever prayed, before you even thought about Him, **He already chose you**, He already loved you, and He was already pulling you toward His heart.

Romans 5:8 (NKJV):

"But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us."

You weren't an accident.

You were a rescue mission.

FIGURE IN JESUS: THE FRIEND WHO WALKS WITH YOU

When you said YES to Jesus, Heaven celebrated—but something else happened instantly:

Matthew 28:20 (NKJV):

Psalm 147:3 (NKJV):

"He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds."

He's not asking you to pretend you're okay.

He's asking you to let Him make you whole.

🙀 JESUS: THE TEACHER WHO LEADS YOU INTO TRUTH

You don't have to know everything right away.

Please don't stress if you don't understand every scripture.

Jesus will teach you step by step, verse by verse, moment by moment.

You aren't expected to know everything—only to follow the One who does.

John 16:13 (NKJV):

"When He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth."

You don't walk blindly—You walk guided.

💢 JESUS: THE STRENGTH IN YOUR WEAKNESS

Christians face attacks, doubts, and spiritual battles. But here is your victory:

Jesus is your STRENGTH.

When you feel weak, He is strong. When you feel unsure, He is steady. When you feel unworthy, He reminds you of His grace.

Philippians 4:13 (NKJV):

"I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me."

You're not living the Christian life in your own strength. You're living it through HIS.

🂢 JESUS: THE KING WHO IS COMING SOON

Following Jesus isn't just about today—it's about eternity.

You joined a kingdom that can't be shaken. You serve a King who will return in glory. Your name is written in the Book of Life. Your future is secure.

Jesus is coming back. And He is coming for YOU.

John 14:3 (NKJV):

"I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also."

CALL TO STRENGTHEN THEIR FAITH

New Christian & Seasoned Christians, This is a reminder!

You are forgiven.

You are chosen.

You are redeemed.

You are set apart.

You are loved with an everlasting love.

You are NOT who you used to be.

You are who Jesus says you are.

Every wound, every trauma, every regret—Jesus is the Healer who binds up broken hearts and restores the soul.

4. Jesus Leads You Into Truth

You don't grow by guessing—you grow by following Him. Through the Holy Spirit, He teaches, corrects, guides, and strengthens you step by step.

5. Jesus Is Coming Back For You

Your faith is not just for this life—but for eternity. Jesus promised to return for His people, and that includes YOU. Your future is secure and your hope is alive.

Here are 3 powerful NKJV scriptures about Jesus coming back...

1. John 14:3 (NKJV)

"And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also."

Jesus Himself promises His return—and that we will be with Him forever.

2. Revelation 1:7 (NKJV)

"Behold, He is coming with clouds, and every eye will see Him, even they who pierced Him. And all the tribes of the earth will mourn because of Him. Even so, Amen."

His return will be visible, powerful, and undeniable.

3. 1 Thessalonians 4:16–17 (NKJV)

"For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God... And thus we shall always be with the Lord."

This is our great hope—He is coming, and we will be with Him forever.

JESUS – THE BREAD OF LIFE WHO WILL FILL YOU UP

There is a hunger inside every human heart that nothing in this world can satisfy. People try to fill it with relationships, money, success, entertainment, food, shopping, habits, and constant distractions—but still end up empty.

Why?

John 6:35 (NKJV):

- ✓ I will *show* you where to find bread

He said:

"I AM THE BREAD."

Meaning:

He is the ONE who fills the empty places.

He is the ONE who satisfies the soul.

He is the ONE who gives life that lasts.

1. Jesus Nourishes Your Soul

Just as bread strengthens your physical body, Jesus strengthens your spirit.

His Word, His presence, His voice—it feeds you from the inside out.

2. Jesus Sustains You Daily

Bread was a daily necessity in Bible times.

Likewise, Jesus is your DAILY source.

Not once a week.

Not only in emergencies.

You need Him every single day.

3. Jesus Satisfies What the World Cannot

Nothing else fills the deep hunger within you. Only Jesus satisfies, comforts, and restores your soul.

4. Jesus Is Enough

Jesus doesn't leave you half full. He fills your mind with peace. He fills your heart with love.

He fills your spirit with strength.

He fills your life with purpose.

THE WORLD FEEDS YOUR FLESH — JESUS FEEDS YOUR SPIRIT

The world leaves you empty. Jesus leaves you overflowing.

The world drains you. Jesus fills you back up.

The world tempts you. Jesus transforms you.

The world offers crumbs. Jesus offers a full table.

- your emptiness becomes joy

Jesus fills every crack, every hole, every broken place. He satisfies the deepest parts of your soul.
