

What It Means to Be LED BY THE SPIRIT

There's something beautiful — and a little bit awe-striking — about someone who walks so closely with God that people begin to ask, “*Are you a seer? Are you a prophet?*”

But the truth is simple and powerful: **You don't have to carry a title to carry the presence of God.**

And you don't need a label to be led.

Every time someone asks me that question, and I respond with,

✨ **“No, I am led by the Holy Spirit,”**

I am giving them the most biblical, grounded answer you could give.

1. Being Led by the Spirit Means You Belong to God

Romans 8:14 (NKJV) says, “*For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God.*”

Being led by the Holy Spirit is not about a title — it's about **relationship**.

It means your identity isn't in what people call you.

Your identity is in Who you follow.

You walk in step with the Spirit because you belong to Him.

2. Being Led by the Spirit Means He Guides Your Steps

The Holy Spirit nudges my heart and yours...

- when to speak
- when to stay silent
- when to go
- when to wait
- when to pray
- when to help
- when to rest

He's like Mine and Your divine GPS — except He never loses signal.

Being led by the Spirit simply means We surrender our decisions, our schedule, our ministry, our work, and my gifts to the Lord, saying:
“Holy Spirit, guide me.”

And He does.

3. Being Led by the Spirit Means You Hear His Voice (John 10:27)

Jesus said: *“My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me.”*

The Holy Spirit SPOKE this loud to me on Sunday afternoon as I was sitting in my car,,, having a Holy Pause Moment..

I don't have to be a prophet to hear Him.
I only have to be His!

Ya'll The Holy Spirit speaks through:

- Scripture
- Holy Pause Moments
- Peace
- Promptings
- Warnings
- Confirmation
- Discernment
- Wisdom
- Revelation while praying or reading the Word

We simply need to obey that voice — joyfully and courageously.

4. Being Led by the Spirit Means You Move in His Power, Not Your Own

The Spirit empowers you and I to pray, teach, write, minister, speak boldly, love deeply, forgive quickly, and obey joyfully.

Acts 1:8 reminds us that the power to minister comes from Him — not from personality, gifting, or titles.

People often **see the fruit** of the Spirit in you and I:

The way we minister...

The way we discern...

The way we speak life...

The way many of us carry the peace of God...

And that's why people ask if I am a seer or a prophet.

But really, they are simply seeing Us as Followers of Jesu Christ who walk with God.

5. Being Led by the Spirit Means You Let Him Lead Every Part of Your Ministry

When you I tell people:

“I’m not a prophet — I’m led by the Spirit,”

I am saying:

“Everything you see me do — it’s not me.

It’s the Holy Spirit working *through* me.”

You/I show up with a willing heart, and He fills the room.

You/I teach, and He breathes revelation on it.

You/I write, and He pours fresh understanding.

You/I pray, and He releases breakthrough.

You/I speak, and He touches hearts.

It's never about the *position* — always about the *Leading*.

So What Does It Mean, Really?

To be led by the Spirit means:

You yield.

You listen.

You obey.

You walk with Him daily.

And He directs your path.

Titles come from people. (Ps Yes I do have a title of Bible Teacher & Evangelist- But I can't do it without God)

Leading comes from God.

And the truth is...

Being led by the Holy Spirit is the highest calling of all.
