General Information

ADMISSION TO THE ARENA

No person will be permitted to enter the arena except participants in the class, judges and their assistants, show photographer and assistant, show officials and staff. Attendants will not be permitted in the arena until summoned by the judge.

ADD/SCRATCH CLASSES

This is not a **RIDE THROUGH THE GATE SHOW** (except for schooling classes). Classes added one hour prior to the class session will be processed at no additional charge and the entry will be assessed the normal class fee. All classes added later than one hour prior to the class session will be assessed a \$10.00 penalty per class and will be assessed the normal class fee. Classes scratched up to one hour prior to the class session will be processed at no charge and the entry will receive a full refund for the class fee. All classes scratched later than one hour prior to the classes session will be assessed a \$10.00 penalty per class and the entry will forfeit the class fee. Forms for adding and scratching are available in the office.

AHA MEMBERSHIP

An **AHA Competition Level Membership** card is required for any owner, trainer, rider, driver or halter handler who exhibits horses or signs the entry form for the horse entered on that form. If proof of this membership is not submitted with the entry, a Single Event Membership must be purchased for \$35 per person not having such proof. A PHOTOCOPY OF YOUR AHA MEMBERSHIP COMPETITION LEVEL CARD MUST ACCOMPANY YOUR ENTRY.

ARENA SCHEDULE

All arenas at Bell Expo have excellent dirt/sand footing. Management reserves the right to change Arena use.

CALL FOR CLASS

Classes will be called promptly. Two (2) minutes will be allowed after the first horse in the class enters the arena, after which the gate will be closed. This will be strictly enforced.

CLASS ENTRIES

Show Management may combine or cancel any class with less than 3 entries or split any class deemed too large. Any performance class with more than 20 horses may be split. If such split does occur, section assignments will be made by Show Management and posted at the Show Office at least one (1) hour prior to the session in which such class occurs. Requests for section changes are honored if the exhibitor locates a willing trade partner who appears in person at the Show Office to confirm. Each section will receive appropriate separate ribbons.

CRUELTY OR ABUSE

In accordance with USEF GR839.5 Cruelty to and Abuse of a Horse: Any action(s) against a horse by a competitor or an exhibitor, which are deemed excessive by a judge, Federation steward, technical delegate or competition veterinarian, in the competition ring or anywhere on the competition grounds may be punished by official warning, elimination, or other sanctions which may be deemed appropriate by the Show Committee. Such action(s) could include, but are not limited to excessive use of the whip, spurs, or bamboo poles.

DISCIPLINE

Any act of dishonesty, discourtesy, or disobedience to any Show Official by an owner, trainer, exhibitor, and/or groom will result in immediate disqualification. Management may remove these persons without liability.

DOGS ON GROUNDS

Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be held on a leash or otherwise restrained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions re-sulting from their dogs' behaviors. NO dogs are allowed in the air conditioned areas of any building in the facility. The penalty is \$200 for violation of this rule in addition to any penalty imposed by the governing bodies. No dogs allowed in the arena(s) at any time.

ENTRY INFORMATION

All entries must be completed on an official entry form along with a copy of all appropriate registration papers for each horse, AHA, USEF and/or WDAA membership cards for each rider and a valid check, PayPal Confirmation or money order for the total amount of appropriate fees; otherwise, the entry will not be accepted and will be subject to the \$50 post entry fee. An entry form is considered entered in the show on the date mailed or emailed to Show Secretary. DO NOT SEND OPEN OR POST DATED CHECKS.

A horse may only be entered under the legal name of the owner. **A copy of the horse registration papers must accompany entry, showing the legal owner of the horse.** If registration papers do not reflect current legal owner, additional paperwork is required—*however, horses without registration papers reflecting current legal owner may not be shown in Amateur Owner or Junior Owner classes without proper sale documentation.* Leased horses may not show in "owner" classes unless the lessee and lessor are members of the same immediate family. In addition to entries of persons suspended or expelled from the USEF or AHA, a recognized competition may refuse any entry of an exhibitor or the participation of any agent, trainer, rider, driver or handler who has shown an objectionable attitude toward a Recognized competition or previous unsportsmanlike behavior at a Recognized competition or its management.

General Information Cont'd

FUND RAISING ACTIVITIES

All fund raising activities on the Bell Expo show grounds must have prior approval from Alamo Arabian Horse Association Board of Directors.

GATE POLICY

Per USEF rules, in classes where horses compete collectively, a warning is issued and the in-gate must be closed two (2) minutes after the first horse enters the ring. No gate hold will be granted unless it involves the same horse or the same rider in back-to-back classes and unless the request is **filed with the Paddock Master prior to the beginning of the session in which the "hold" occurs. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITOR TO BE SURE THAT HIS/HER HORSE IS AT THE GATE ON TIME. CLASS CALLS MUST BE CONSIDERED A COURTESY ONLY.** No protests will be upheld on the basis of a public address system malfunction.

GOVERNING ORGANIZATIONS

This Show is conducted within the rules of the United States Equestrian Federation ("USEF"), the Arabian Horse Association ("AHA"), and the United States Dressage Federation ("USDF"). The official rules of these organizations shall prevail; any change or correction of these rules automatically becomes part of this premium book. Each participant is subject to all rules as they apply. The Show Committee, whose decision shall be final, will decide any issue or matter not covered by the rulebooks of these organizations. **EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.**

HAY & GRAIN SUPPLIERS

Hay or grain is not available at the facility.

HEALTH CERTIFICATE/COGGINS REQUIREMENTS

Any Texas horse entering the grounds must be accompanied by 1) documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccination within six months prior to entering the facility (see USEF GR845), and (2) a negative Coggins issued within 12 months by a licensed veterinarian. **Per Texas law, any out-of-state horse entering the grounds must be accompanied by a health certificate issued within 45 days of the show as well as a negative Coggins issued within 12 months.** These must be presented at the Show Office prior to receiving entry numbers. Horses with any communicable diseases must immediately be removed from the show grounds.

HELMET / VEST RULE

Affirmation of the United States Equestrian Federation Helmet/Vest Rule GR801.4 Dress. Any exhibitor may wear protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) and/or a protective safety vest, specifically designed for use in equestrian sport in any division or class without penalty from the judge. The Federation recommends that the vest meet or surpass the current ASTM standard or be certified by the Safety Equipment Institute.

HORSE SHOW MOVE-IN & MOVE-OUT

REGULAR MOVE-IN – Regular move-in begins WEDNESDAY, April 10th at 12:00 Noon.

EARLY MOVE-IN – Begins before Regular Move-in date and will be charged at a rate of \$30/Day.

DEPARTURE – All accounts must be paid in full by the close of the Show Office on Saturday, April 13th and prior to departure. All horses, tack and possessions must be removed from the grounds by 11:59 AM Sunday, April 14th.

INDEMNITY & RESPONSIBILITY

Every entry is submitted with the understanding that the Alamo Arabian Horse Association and/or the Bell County Expo are not liable for loss, injury or damage to horses, persons or any possessions while at the show. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, and the exhibitor shall indemnify the above mentioned parties against any and all loss, damages and liability thus occasioned, including but not limited to any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. The owner indemnifies the Alamo Arabian Horse Association, its directors, officers and/or members, the Show, Show Staff and the Bell County Expo against any and all loss, damage and/or liability including but not limited to legal costs incurred as a result. **THE SUBMITTING OF AN ENTRY FORM TO THE SHOW SHALL CONSTITUTE AN ACCEPTANCE BY EACH PERSON SIGNING SAME OF THE PROVISIONS HEREIN SET FORTH.**

WARNING - Under Texas Law (Chapter 87, Civil Practice and Remedies Code), an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

INDEBTEDNESS TO SHOW

Any exhibitor who fails to settle his or her indebtedness to this show will automatically be reported to AHA, under AHA Handbook SUS 102 and to USEF, under USEF Rule Book Article GR 913.

JUDGES

With the exception Sport Horse, all classes will be judged by two judges as a Region 9 concurrent qualifying show. This show will be judged according to the single judge system. In the event of illness or failure of a judge or any other official to attend this show or to perform his duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute an official for the one officially designated in the prize list according to USEF Rules.

LONGEING

There will be no longeing allowed in Main Arena or the Paddock areas while show is in session in that area. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

POST ENTRIES

After deadline of Monday, March 25, 2024, entries are accepted on a space available basis for an one-time post entry fee of \$50 per horse.

PROTEST

A protest must be filed as set forth by USEF.

REFUNDS

Official notice must be received by the Show Secretary prior to the Entry Closing Deadline of Monday, March 25, 2024 if any entry is to be withdrawn. Office Fee is non-refundable. Otherwise, no refund will be paid. After March 25, 2024, only withdrawals approved by a vet are honored if received in the Show Office by 6:00 PM on Wednesday April 10, 2024. If so, only Class Entry Fees will be refunded—there will be no refund for Stall, Office, or other Fees. After 6:00 P.M. on April 10, 2024, no Fees will be refunded. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to notify the Show Office during the show (or the Show Secretary within 30 days of the show) of any and all refunds due. Refund checks will be mailed within 30 days after AAHA Board Approval. If any show fees are paid by credit card, the credit card processing fee will not be refunded.

RV PARKING

RV parking is available at the Bell Expo on a first come, first served basis. And the rate is \$40 per day per plug. RV must clearly display RV Pass provided by Show.

SHARPS CONTAINERS

Competition management shall have placed a minimum of one sharps container per 50 horses for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments in convenient locations in the barn. Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

SHAVINGS

Shavings **MUST** be purchased from the Alamo Arabian Horse Association at the show. These shavings are at a cost of \$13.00. Using bedding (other than shavings) that requires special clean-up by the facility will result in a \$35 per stall clean-up fee. **NO OUTSIDE SHAVING PERMITTED**

SHOW OFFICE HOURS

The Show Office will be open for exhibitor check-in Wednesday, April 10th from 10:00 AM to 7:00 PM. On Show Days, the office will open at 7:00 AM and remain open until 30 minutes past the end of the show that evening. All accounts must be settled by the end of the show on Saturday, April 13, 2024.

STALL & FACILITIES INFORMATION

All stalls will be assigned by the **Barn Manager—Elizabeth Williams (210-639-4708)**. All horses are required to have stalls and no stalls will be used without payment of appropriate fees. Requests for adjoining stalls from different owners may not be honored unless requested on each owner's entry form and the entry forms mailed together. Stalls will be considered reserved only when entry forms and appropriate monies are received by the Show Secretary. Stalls are 12' x 12' wood provided with doors and with base material. There are three covered arenas which are Main Arena : 130' by 300'; Warm Up: 100' by 200' and Upper Arena 100' x 200'.

STALLIONS

Stallions are prohibited in Equitation, Leadline, Walk/Trot (except for Adult Walk/Trot), and Youth Showmanship classes.

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR. WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP. SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS, BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS. (BOD 5/12)

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT (GR 901.9)

2024 MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage Competitions, Endurance Rides and Vaulting Competitions: (See GR828.4 of the Federation rules). Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

SAFE SPORT

Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.
Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. WASH RACKS

Horses must be washed in the wash racks provided by the facility. Washing of horses in any other location is prohibited.

General Information Cont'd

ATTENTION ALL JUNIORS! Motorized Vehicle Statement

No roller blades, skateboards, or scooters may be brought to the show—they are not an acceptable mode of transportation around horses at this show. In accordance with GR1301.7: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

BUY-A-CLASS

Simply request any class or any championship class which has a qualifying class. All Buy-A-Classes must be chosen and paid for by entry closing date, so that other exhibitors may be notified. You pay \$75 Buy-A-Class fee in addition to the regular class fee for the regular class and \$150 for the Championship class. IF the Buy-A-Class has three or more riders, the Buy-A-Class fee will be refunded. The person buying the class will be announced as the class sponsor. No one individual, trainer, or barn may buy more than two classes, unless all classes are not sold within five days of entry closing. All must be approved by Show Committee. The following age breaks will be permitted: 10 & Under, 11-13, 13 & under, 14-18, 19-39, 40 & Over and 50 & Over. Classes may NOT be purchased if they already exist in the show schedule. The following classes will be permitted with show committee approval:

Any class on the AHA Class List or that is recognized by AHA is eligible, with the exception of: Dressage, Western Dressage, Sport Horse, Halter, Trail, Ranch Trail, Reining, Ranch Riding, Cutting, Working Cow, Reined Cow, Team Penning, Working Hunter, Jumper, Hunter Seat Equitation Over Obstacles, Hunter Over Fences, Jumper, Eventing, Hunter Hack, Combined Driving, Driven Dressage, Hunter Classic & Mini-Prix, Working Hunter Warm-Up, Competitive Trail, Endurance, Get/Produce of Sire/Dam, Poles, Barrels, Racing, any single go class and Liberty.

Show Management retains right of approval of class. For your assistance, classes may be designated with (but not limited to):

- Age or Age Splits (In some cases, both age splits will need to be purchased)
- Open, AT, AAT, JT, AOT, AAOT, JOT, Junior Horse, Select, Championships
- Maiden, Novice, Limit, Ladies, Gentlemen, Stallions, Mares, Geldings (Open, AT, AAT, JT, AOT, AAOT, JOT, Junior Horse, Select, Championships)
- AOTS - Amateur Owned, Trained, and Shown (see USEF Rulebook AR110.3)
- Futurity/Maturity

Sweepstakes eligible class will not count towards sweepstakes points.

Once you buy a class you are locked into that class. You can not change or cancel the class!

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT FEDERATION RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

Exhibitors are encouraged to read the USEF rule book, and particularly Chapter AR, for the complete Arabian, Half-Arabian and Anglo-Arabian competition rules, class descriptions and judging specifications.

Amateur: For the Arabian Division, adult amateurs are defined as those no longer eligible to compete as junior exhibitors. Every adult amateur contestant that has reached his 19th birthday as of December 1st of the previous calendar year must hold amateur status. Every person who has reached his/her 19th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under Federation rules must possess current amateur certification issued by the Federation. This certification must be available for inspection or the competitor must have lodged with the competition secretary, at least one hour prior to such class. An application form for such certification may be obtained from the Federation. Certification will be issued only on receipt of the application properly signed and is revocable at any time for cause. See USEF GR Subchapter13-B, GR1307, AR110.7, and AHA Chapter 2. Section 2. Paragraph c.

Age Splits: Age Splits will be at Show Management discretion.

Headers and Leaders: Headers in Walk-Trot and leaders in Leadline classes must be at least 14 years of age.

Junior Exhibitor: An individual who has not reached his 19th birthday as of December 1st of the previous calendar year which is the start of the current competition year. For Horse Show purposes, the age of the junior exhibitor on December 1 of the show year shall be maintained throughout the entire year.

Leadline 2-6: Open to riders who are at least two years of age and have not reached their seventh birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year. See GR115. Leaders must be at least fourteen years of age. Boots are required & rider's feet must be engaged in the stirrups/iron. See USEF Subchapter AR31 for requirements & specifications.

Schooling Classes:

Schooling classes will be run like a regular class with a ring master, music, announcer and line up. There will not be a judge in the ring. The cost will be \$10.00 per horse which will be added to the exhibitor's bill and paid at check out. The Paddock Master must be notified before the end of the regular session and before schooling class if you have a horse that will participate. Schooling classes will run only when time permits. Show attire and tack not required. Training tack and radio headsets will be allowed.

AHA ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION This document waives very important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

In consideration for AHA permitting me to participate in this Competition, and by signing the entry blank, I agree as follows:
I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. **I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN, AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.**
I AGREE as a Horse Show Participant (or Parent/Guardian of Participant if a minor) to waive all claims which may otherwise arise from, including but not limited to infectious bacteria, viruses, fungi/mold, parasites or other agents which may be present at the Horse Show (and most other outdoor locations) and can cause infection in humans, as well as in animals.

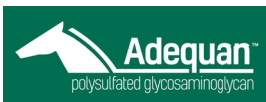

Membership Requirements for USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized Competitions: Owners and riders, including foreign riders and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition as a rider or owner/lessee, must have either a USDF Group Membership (GM), Participating Membership (PM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification number and pay the USDF Non-Member (NM) fee. (Note: USDF Business Members can own horses but cannot compete as riders with their USDF Business Membership.)

Horses competing at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions must have either a USDF Horse Identification (HID) number or a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR). Proper credentials or verification certificates must be presented to the competition secretary.

Riders and owners wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition, and not able to present the competition secretary with verification of a USDF membership or NM identification, and USDF LHR or USDF HID, must complete a USDF Competition Affidavit Form and pay the \$5 affidavit filing fee. A copy of a completed affidavit form from another competition may also be used for verification purposes for up to 60 days. (Exception: Affidavits cannot be used at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championships.)

Exceptions:

- Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBCs) at DSHB competitions, sires and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where those sires or dams are not actually competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes at Regular Competitions (e.g. all Arabian, all Friesian, or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, pas de deux or quadrille, are exempt from this requirement. Also exempt are horses ridden in leadline, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walk-trot, academy, and opportunity classes.
- Riders and owners/lessees competing only in classes which are exempt from the USDF HID requirements are also exempt from the USDF NM identification number and NM fee requirements. Also exempt are handlers of horses competing in DSHB In-Hand or Group classes.

Memberships Defined

Participating Membership (PM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30. PMs are available for 1-year (\$90), 5-years (\$360), or life (\$1,800). A USDF Youth Participating Membership (YPM) is available for individuals who have not reached their 21st birthday by December 1 of the current membership year (\$72). A PM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or owner/lessee for all Adequan[®]/USDF Year-End Awards and the Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championship program.

Group Membership (GM): A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an affiliate Group Member Organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and participate in the USDF Rider Awards Program and the USDF Regional Schooling Show Awards Program.

Business Membership (BM): A membership that runs December 1 through November 30 and is issued to a business or organization directly by USDF. The USDF BM (\$240) offers a wider variety of advertising benefits. BMs satisfy requirements of horse ownership only.

Non-Member (NM) Identification Number: For each USDF NM owner/lessee and USDF NM rider there will be a USDF NM fee of \$35 per competition that must be collected by the show secretary and submitted to USDF, along with the USDF Report of Fees document and the \$5 affidavit fee and Competition Affidavit Form if the person cannot provide a copy of their USDF NM card. Owners/lessees or riders exempt from the NM number requirements are also exempt from paying the USDF NM fee. If there are multiple owners of a horse and all are NMs, only one of the owners must pay the NM fee. If the horse has at least one owner who is a current USDF PM, GM, or BM there is no NM fee assessed. Competition management will be invoiced for all applicable USDF NM fees not received with the USDF post-competition paperwork, along with a report listing all USDF NMs. Competition management is then required to submit the NM fees within 30 days to the USDF. An individual with a USDF NM identification number is not eligible for any USDF membership benefits. Once a USDF NM number has been assigned, a USDF NM card can be obtained from the USDF website.

Horse Identification (HID) Number: A one-time tracking number for horses (\$35). Scores earned by a horse with an HID number will be recorded but will NOT be counted towards Adequan[®]/USDF Year-End Awards. A horse with an HID number is not eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying or championship classes. An HID number can be upgraded to a Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) for a fee of \$80. If a horse has a USDF LHR it does not need an HID number. An HID number is a one-time fee that does not need to be renewed.

Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR): A horse with an LHR (\$115) is eligible for Adequan[®]/USDF Year-End Awards, and eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying and championship classes, assuming requirements for the owner and rider are met. If a horse has an LHR it does not need an HID number. An LHR does not need to be renewed.

How to Join USDF

Applications for USDF Participating Membership (PM), Business Membership (BM), Horse Identification (HID) number, and Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) may be found in the following locations:

- On the USDF website: www.usdf.org. You can submit the application online or download the form.
- In the show office at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions classified by USEF as Dressage Competitions, and Regular Competitions which are open to all breeds.

The effective date of membership is the date the form and correct fees are received in the USDF office or, if applying at a competition, the date accepted by the competition secretary, provided the application is signed and dated by the competition secretary, member, and/or horse owner on that same day.

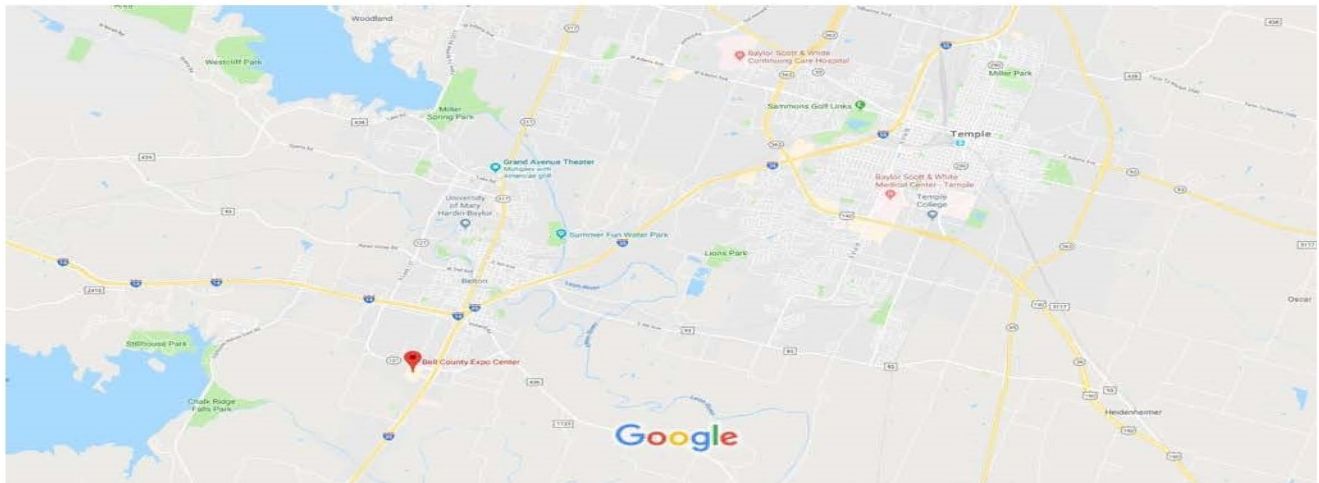
