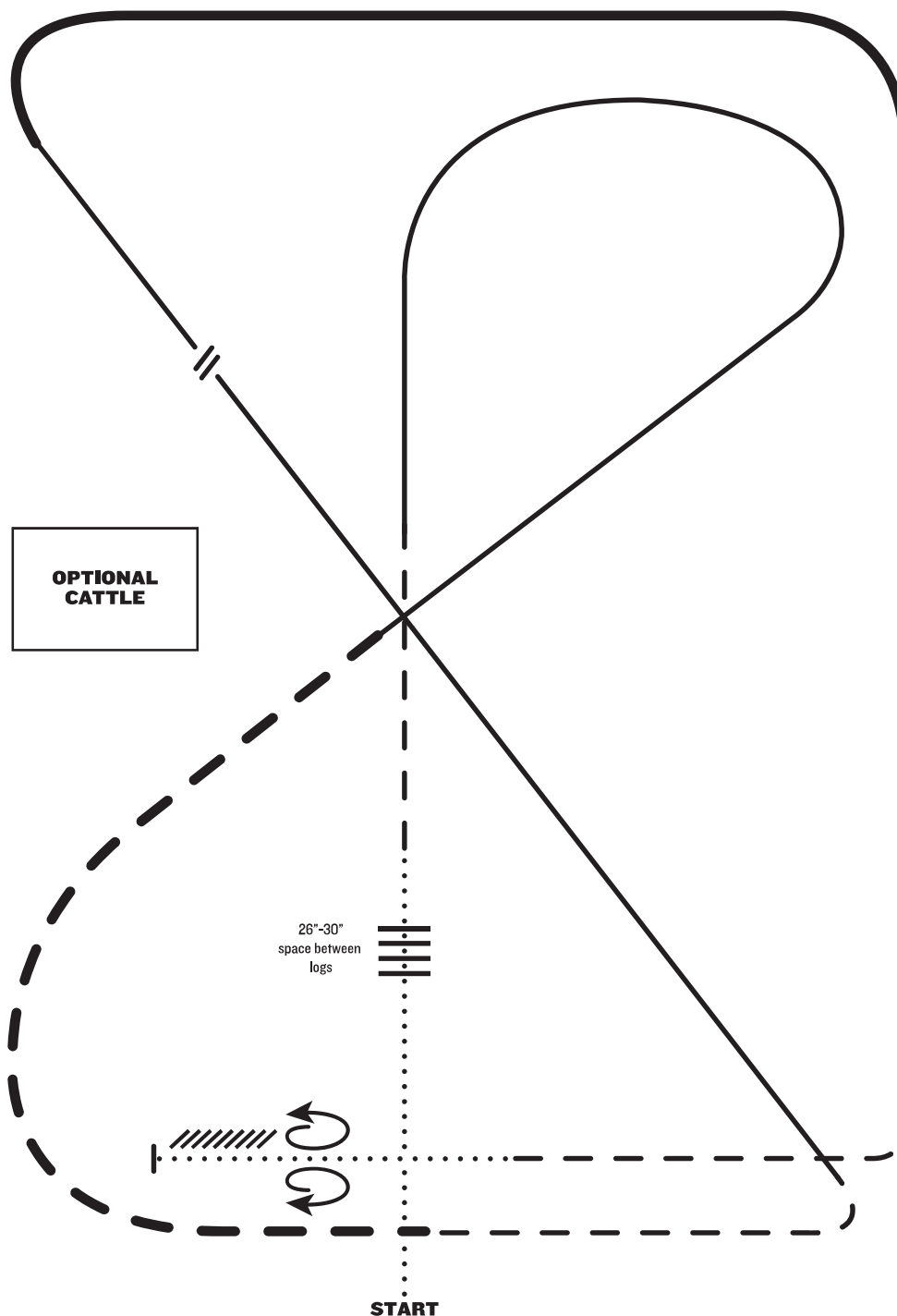


RANCH RIDING - PATTERN 5

1. Walk
2. Walk over logs
3. Trot
4. Lope right lead
5. Extended trot
6. Trot
7. Lope left lead
8. Change leads (simple or flying)
9. Extended lope right lead
10. Collect lope
11. Trot
12. Walk
13. Stop and back
14. 360° turn each direction (either direction 1st) (L-R or R-L)

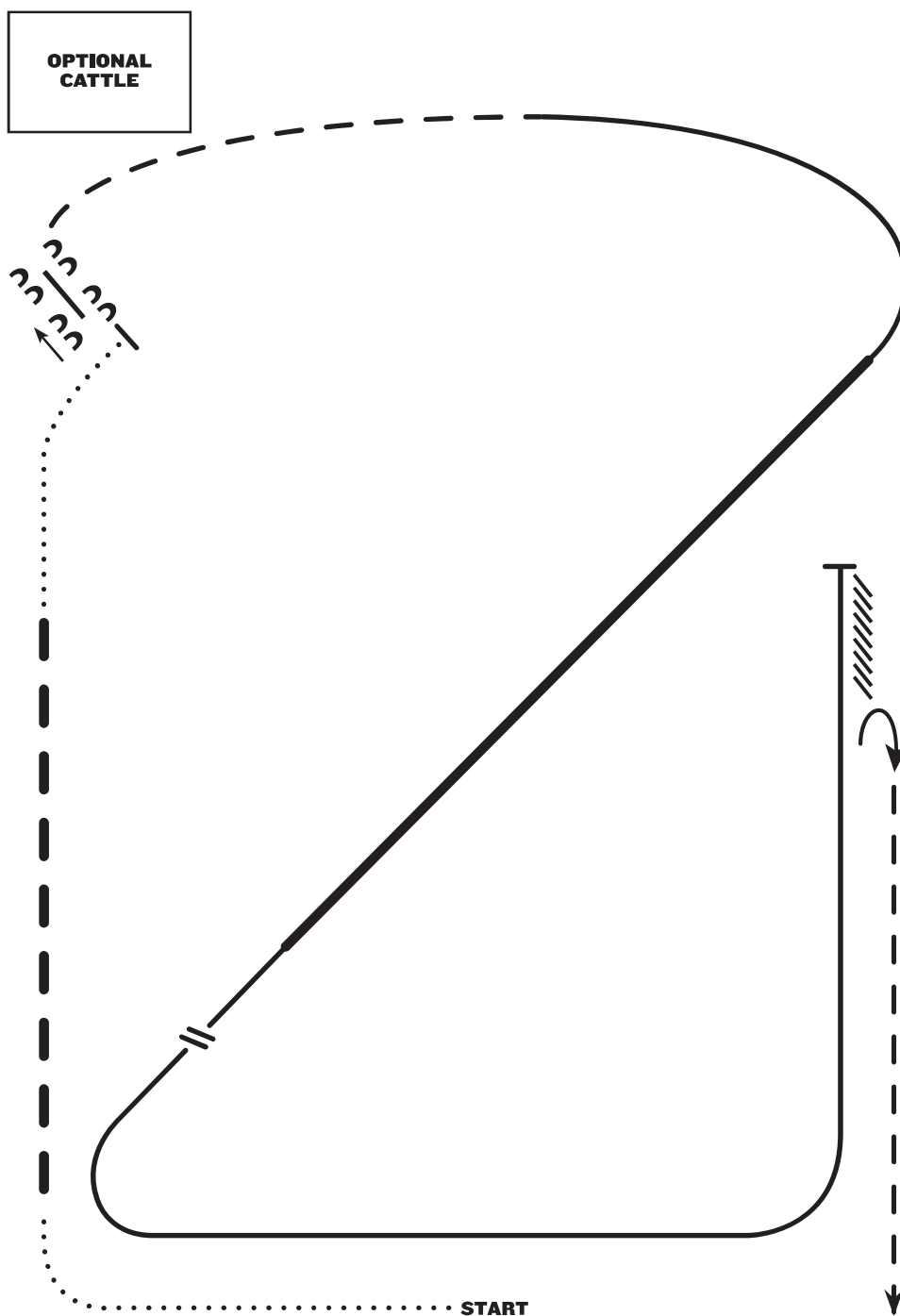

8. Collect lope and change leads (simple or flying)
9. Lope left lead
10. Stop and back
11. 1/2 turn right
12. Trot

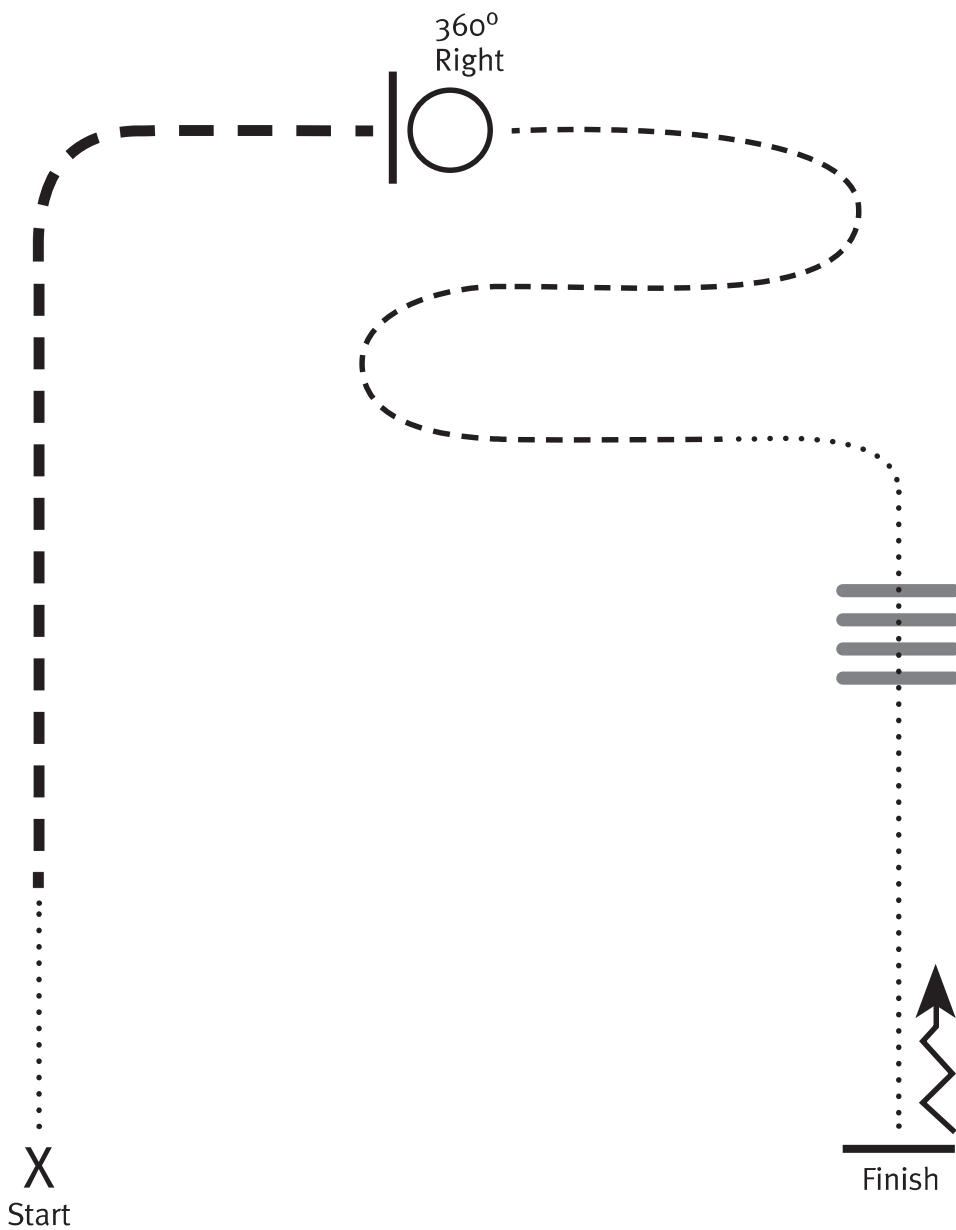

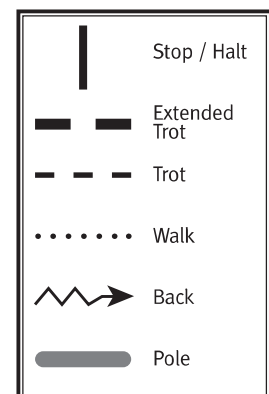
To be used for Walk/Trot 10 & Under and 11 & Over

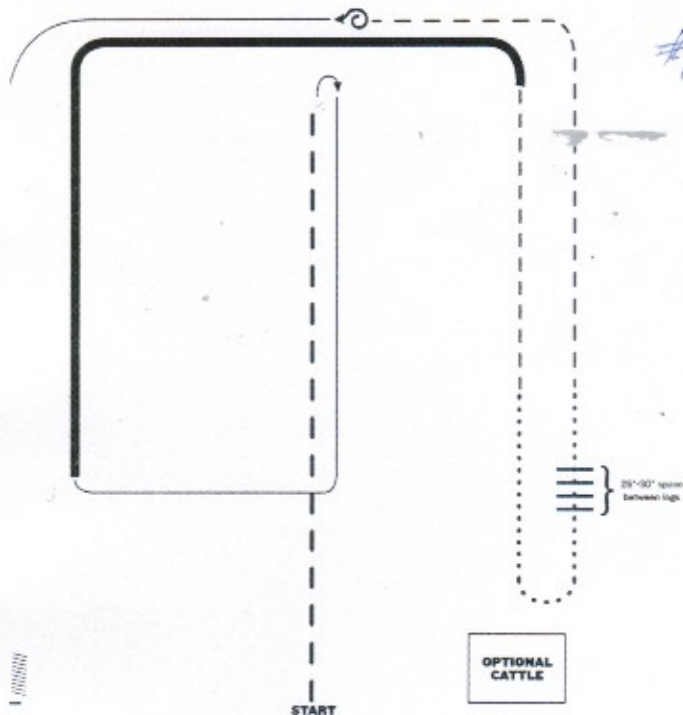

- Be ready at start.
- Walk.
- Extended trot.
- Stop. Turn 360-degrees right.
- Trot serpentine.
- Walk.
- Walk over poles.
- Stop, and back.
- Exit the arena at the walk.





1. Extended trot
2. Stop, rollback right
3. Lope right lead
4. Extended lope (right lead)
5. Trot
6. Walk
7. Walk over logs
8. Walk
9. Trot
10. Stop, 360 left
11. Lope left lead
12. Stop and back
