

Class Information – The Jingle Mingle Horse Show

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN, WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES & SPECIFICATIONS OF CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK, WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

All Classes in the Class Schedule are designated what Breed they are for:

PB – Purebred Arabian HA/AA – Half/Anglo Arabian; AL – Purebred Andalusian HA/L – Half Andalusian Opportunity Open Breeds – Are open to all Registered Horses; all Equitation is open to Breed Noted in Class Name Amateur To Ride/Handle; All Walk-Trot Classes are open to Breed Noted in Class name; Walk-Whoa is open to All Breeds

Leadline - Stallions are prohibited. Rider's age 2 to 6 years, the "leader" must be at least 14 years of age. Safety is of the utmost importance in tack and attire: Saddle must fit rider; rider's feet must be engaged in the stirrups/ irons; lead rein may be attached to a cavesson or halter placed under or over bridle; safety helmets, with chin straps, may be used by any rider regard-less of style of tack and/or attire; boots, long pants and long sleeve shirts are required (Res. 34-99). Leadline riders cannot cross-enter any other class in show. Leadline classes are exempt from AHA/USEF membership.

Walk – Whoa – 8 Yrs and Under: This class is designed as a bridge from Leadline to Walk Trot - Open to riders 8 years of age and under. Stallions are prohibited. Riders must have never been judged in any class at a competition that required a jog/trot, canter or lope. The safety of all exhibitors is the primary concern in these classes. <u>Each exhibitor is allowed to have 1 coach in the ring with them</u>, the coach may have NO Physical contact unless the exhibitor is in trouble - Any action by any exhibitor that endangers any other exhibitor must be severely penalized or excused, at the judge's discretion. Proper attire is required. No Cross Entry of Rider Allowed, this class is Exempt from AHA/USEF Membership.

Walk/Trot Pleasure and Equitation - 10 & Under - Open to riders 10 years of age and under. Stallions are prohibited. Riders must have never been judged in any class at an approved USEF or AHA competition that required a canter or lope. The safety of all exhibitors is the primary concern in these classes. Any action by any exhibitor that endangers any other exhibitor must be severely penalized or excused, at the judge's discretion. Proper attire is required per appropriate USEF rules. In equitation no tests will be called.

Walk/Trot Pleasure and Equitation – 11 & Over – Open to all riders 11 years of age and over. Stallions are prohibited. Riders must have never been judged in any class at an approved USEF or AHA competition that required a canter or lope. The safety of all exhibitors is the primary concern in these classes. Any action by any exhibitor that endangers any other exhibitor must be severely penalized or excused, at the judge's discretion. Proper attire is required per appropriate USEF rules. In equitation no tests will be called.

Halter Showmanship - Open to mares and geldings. NO STALLIONS.

Driving - Headers are permitted but not mandatory.

Opportunity Open Breed Classes will use the English Pleasure Division rules from the USEF Rule Book where they apply. Horses may be of any breed or combination of breeds. All classes are open to horses and ponies. Horses must be serviceably sound, and in good condition. Animals with complete loss of sight in one eye may be found serviceably sound at the judge's discretion.

The use of artificial appliances or devices such as chains, shackles, rubber bands, blinkers (except when driving) or blindfolds is prohibited on the grounds before or during a competition. Any animal with prohibited equipment must be disqualified from further competition and forfeit all entry fees and winnings. Tails must not be gingered or put in any device (e.g. tailset, bustle, braced, tied, etc.) which alters their carriage while on the grounds. The fact that a horse's tail has previously been set does not exclude participation.

Practice Classes – Are open to all Breeds and All seats unless noted otherwise. Horse Back Numbers must be worn. Gaits will be called by the Announcer, it is preferred that all horses entered perform the gait called. Schooling Attire and Equipment is Allowed.

<u>Fun Classes are open to all breeds and all ages – Class Fees will be Donated to the Arabian</u> Horseman's Distress Fund

<u>Musical Poles Fun Class</u> – this is similar to Musical Chairs, each rider will be asked to ride the arena at a specific gait, when the music stops you find the nearest spot (will be marked with cones or Ribbon) last person without a marker is out, and so on until only 1 remains.

Simon Says – this classic game is fun for all, follow directions and be the last person in the game to win a prize.

Champagne Toast Fun Class – This class is similar to Egg and Spoon, each rider will be given a glass with Iced Tea in it – the rider at the end of the class with the most Liquid left in their glass is the winner, If your glass is empty – you are out. Class is open to all breeds and seats, standard gaits will be called (walk, jog/trot, lope/canter, halt - both ways of the ring) Entry Fee is \$50 and all class fees collected will be donated to the Horseman's Distress Fund

<u>Ugly Christmas Sweater Costume Class</u> – Dress yourself and your horse up in an Ugly Sweater Costume. Class will be judged like a Fantasy Costume Class. Horses to be presented at the Walk either ridden, driven or In-Hand (like a parade class). Entry Fee is \$50 and all class fees collected will be donated to the Horseman's Distress Fund.

General Information, Rules & Regulations

Entries - Entries close, November 24, 2025, those received after this date must possess a valid postmark or owner will be charged the post entry fee. All entries must be completed on an official entry form for this show and have included a valid check, money order or Credit Card Receipt for the total show fees. A horse may only be entered under the legal name of the owner; no horse may be entered on more than one entry form. **Leased horses may not be shown in Amateur or Junior Owner classes.**

Electronic Entries – Entry Close is November 24, 2025 – To Save time and expense if you want to scan and email your entries in .PDF (Adobe) format you may – Please email to <u>Bethwalker5@Hotmail.com</u> – If you do not receive a confirmation of receipt within a few days please call me at (225) 772-6815 – Please include Completed Entry Form and Credit Card Receipt must be included.

We will also be using the Ring Radar horse show management software this year, this site will allow you to enter your horses, upload coggins & vaccination information, upload your memberships and your horses membership numbers, add & scratch classes, view patterns and orders of go and checkout with a credit card. We are trying this software to see how it will work for future shows in Region 9, if exhibitors like it you may see it at more shows. Once you create your account, you can upload your info and it stays in the file to make ease of entering at other shows much simpler.

Returned Checks/Declined Credit Cards (NSF): Exhibitor will be charged \$50, in addition to bank charges assessed for NSF Checks. If payment is not received within Ten (10) days of notice given to clear amounts owed, plus NSF Fee and bank charges - exhibitor's name will be turned in to AHA and USEF and will be unable to show until amounts owed are paid in full.

Coggins / Vaccination Records - Any out of state horse entering the grounds must be accompanied by a current health certificate issued within 30 days by a licensed vet and presented at the Show Office. Horses with any communicable disease must immediately leave the show grounds. **A negative Coggins issued within 12 prior months is required for all horses.**

USEF Vaccination Rule 1. At Federation licensed competitions, horses 7 months of age, entering the show grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhino Pneumonitis) vaccinations within six months of entering the show stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request of the Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered under the direction of a veterinarian.

MICROCHIPPING The US Equestrian Board of Directors approved a new microchipping rule during the 2023 Mid-Year Board meeting. Beginning December 1, 2025, under GR1101.1., all horses competing in USEF licensed or endorsed competitions must be microchipped with a 15-digit ISO compliant 11784/11785 chip. https://www.usef.org/compete/resources-forms/competition-management/competition-safety-biosecurity/microchipping

Amateur Classes – all riders in Amateur Classes MUST HAVE in their possession an Amateur Card issued by the USEF or make application for such card prior to riding in these classes. Applications are available on the USEF Website. All Amateurs must be active members of the Federation.

Cruelty or Abuse – Cruelty or Abuse is forbidden anywhere on the grounds. The show committee shall penalize such actions (USEF Rule III, Art 302) Excessive harm to any horse (including harm caused by a whip or any other object) anywhere on the grounds before, during or after the show renders the offender subject to penalty. Judges shall enforce this policy in the show ring. A signed entry blank constitutes acceptance of this policy.

Care of Animals – Exhibitors are required to keep their animals as well as stalls clean and neat with refuse matter disposed of as the Horse Show Management may direct. Humane treatment must be exercised at all times by all exhibitors and their employees.

Class Post Entries – All added classes (classes not entered on original entry blank) must be entered ONE HOUR prior to the start of the class session you want to show in or you will be charged a \$10.00 late entry fee.

Class Scratches – Any class scratched in the office ONE HOUR prior to the start of the session will have the class fee refunded. Dressage, Sport Horse In Hand, and Trail Class fees will not be refunded under any condition

Discipline – Any act of dishonesty, discourtesy or disobedience to any Show Official by an owner, trainer, groom or exhibitor will result in disqualification. Management may remove an owner/trainer/groom/exhibitor without liability.

<u>Dogs and Other Pets:</u> No dogs are allowed in any stands, buildings, or arena areas. Dogs and other **pets** are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be *held* on a leash or otherwise *restrained*. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Pet owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty.

Number of Entries – Show Management reserves the right to consolidate or cancel any class in which there are not at least three (3) entries.

Photographer Fee – We are **NOT** charging the \$25 per horse fee to assist in covering the cost of providing a great show photographer, but everyone will still have access to the show file. The show will post a link so that you can have access to the show file and you can have as many of the Low-Res files as you want. Hi-Res files must be purchased directly from the photographer – Genie Images.

Responsibility – All Entries are accepted with the understanding that neither the South Central Arabians of Texas Club, Arabian Horse Club of Texas or the San Antonio Rose Palace will be liable for any loss, injury or damage to horses, persons or any possessions while at the show. The authority of Show Management shall oversee all horses, although they remain the risk of the owner, exhibitor or trainer responsible for loss. Thus, the owner indemnifies the South Central Arabians of Texas Club, Arabian Horse Club of Texas and the San Antonio Rose Palace against any and all loss, damage and/or liability including but not limited to legal costs incurred as a result. A signed entry form constitutes acceptance of this policy.

Stalls and stall assignments – Stalls are full 12x12 box stalls of wood construction and have swing doors. Stalls will be available at 8:00 AM on Wednesday December 10, 2025 and must be vacated by 8:00 PM SUNDAY December 7, 2025. EARLY ARRIVAL must be confirmed in advance and is available. Early Move-In or Late Move-Out fees will apply to any stall occupied other than at these times at \$35.00 per day/per stall. Stalls will be assigned by Show Management upon receipt of stall fees. REQUESTS FOR ADJOINING STALLS MUST STATE THE SAME STABLING NAME AND ARE NOT GUARANTEED BUT WILL BE HONORED IF POSSIBLE. Exhibitors will be charged for any stalls they use for any reason.

Show Post Entries – Post entries for show will be accepted for horses after closing date of November 25, 2025 at the regular fees plus the per horse post entry fee of \$40.00 (paid once per horse, not per class). NEW HORSES MUST BE ENTERED NO LATER THAN Thursday at 8:00 Pm or the night before they plan to be shown, for example a horse showing in a class on Saturday must be entered prior to end of the show day on Friday.

Stallions - Stallions may be shown by ladies and children, except in Junior Halter Showmanship, Leadline, Walk/Whoa and Walk/Trot classes.

Scratches - Official notice must be received by Wednesday December 10, 2025. Scratch Notices accompanied by a Vet/Medical certificate will receive all fee's less the office fee & Credit card fee if entry was paid with a credit card. Scratches without a Vet/Medical certificate will receive class fees only. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to notify the show office during the show of any or all refunds due. All classes are nonrefundable after beginning of show Session. Refunds will be applied to Show Account. Refund checks are mailed 30 days after the end of the show. All Dressage Rides and Sport Horse In Hand Classes are not refundable once rides have been scheduled (Approximately December 3, 2025)

Footing is sandy loam and clay. The Arena "A" is 120' x 255'. Arena "B" is 112' x 250'

Wash Rack – Washing of horses in any other location than wash racks provided is prohibited.

Governing Organizations - This show is conducted in accordance with the rules of the United States Equestrian Federation (USEF), the Arabian and Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian Divisions (AR), Andalusian Division (AL), Dressage Division (DR), Western Dressage Division (WD), and English Pleasure Division (EP). The official rules of these organizations shall prevail; any change or correction of these rules automatically becomes part of this premium. Each participant is subject to all rules as they apply. Any questions not covered by the rule books of these organizations shall be decided by the Show Committee, whose decision will be final.

IALHA - Owners and their horses are to be members of the IALHA Association. All participants are to be compliant with USEF Membership/Show Pass rules that have been updated. Competing horses will need a USEF Horse Recording Number or a Horse ID Number. The current rule book can be found at www.usef.org. This is a USEF licensed event.

Registration Requirements: *Arabians:* Horses shown in this division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Registry of America, Inc., and/or the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry, or, if under one year of age, be eligible for registry and registration applied for (Exception: Art. 1699V.1) and must be entered under their full registered name. (Only weanlings that have had registration applied for may show without registration papers.) A copy of the registration papers showing proof of ownership must be submitted with entry form at the time of making entries. Competition management is responsible for notifying exhibitors of this requirement. *Half-Arabians:* Horses shown in this section must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Association in the Half-Arabian or the Anglo-Arabian Registry, or have been issued an Arabian Horse Association (Canadian Partbred Arabian Registry) CPAR PERMIT, or if under one year of age, be eligible for registry and registration applied for and must be entered under their full registered name.

Registration Requirements: IALHA - All Horses must have completed the IALHA Registration and have the certificate to compete

Important: A photocopy of the registration papers (Andalusian Horses only need copies) (do not send originals) must accompany each entry. Entries without these copies will be charged \$25 for an Incomplete Entry. All required AHA and USEF membership numbers must be on the entry form. All Horses must have a USEF Horse ID Number, All WDAA Horses must have a Horse number. Back Numbers will not be assigned unless entry forms are complete. Incomplete Entries will be charged \$25.00

Competition Level Membership cards are required, or a single-event membership must be purchased for AHA \$40.00, WDAA \$45.00, IALHA \$25.00 and USEF Show Pass \$45.00 These Memberships & Show Passes must be purchased on the corresponding organizations website prior to the beginning of the show. All exhibitors missing memberships will be charged the Incomplete Entry Form Fee.

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR. WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP.

SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS.

EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS.

EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS. (BOD 5/12)

USEF Membership Statement

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

Motorized Vehicle Statement: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discret ion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheel ed scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.





<u>USDF Membership Benefits:</u> USDF is dedicated to education, the recognition of achievement, and promotion of dressage. For details on member benefits, including educational programs, awards, and other opportunities, refer to the *USDF Member Guide* or the USDF website at www.usdf.org.

Membership Requirements for USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized Competitions: Owners and riders, including foreign riders and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition as a rider or owner/lessee, must have either a USDF Group Membership (GM), Participating Membership (PM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification number and pay the USDF Non-Member (NM) fee. (Note: USDF Business Members can own horses but cannot compete as riders with their USDF Business Membership.)

Horses competing at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions must have either a USDF Horse Identification (HID) number or a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR). Proper credentials or verification certificates must be presented to the competition secretary.

Riders and owners wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition, and not able to present the competition secretary with verification of a USDF membership or NM identification, and USDF LHR or USDF HID, must complete a USDF Competition Affidavit Form and pay the \$5 affidavit filing fee. A copy of a completed affidavit form from another competition may also be used for verification purposes for up to 60 days. (Exception: Affidavits cannot be used at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championships.)

Exceptions:

- Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBCs) at DSHB competitions, sires and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where those
 sires or dams are not actually competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes at Regular
 Competitions (e.g. all Arabian, all Friesian, or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, pas de deux or quadrille, are exempt from
 this requirement. Also exempt are horses ridden in leadline, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walk-trot, academy, and
 opportunity classes.
- Riders and owners/lessees competing only in classes which are exempt from the USDF HID requirements are also exempt from the USDF NM
 identification number and NM fee requirements. Also exempt are handlers of horses competing in DSHB In-Hand or Group classes.

Memberships Defined

Participating Membership (PM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30. PMs are available for 1-year (\$100), 5-years (\$400), or life (\$2,000). A USDF Youth Participating Membership (YPM) is available for individuals who have not reached their 21st birthday by December 1 of the current membership year (\$80). A PM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or owner/lessee for all Adequans/USDF Year-End Awards and the Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championship program.

Group Membership (GM): A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an affiliate Group Member Organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and participate in the USDF Rider Awards Program.

Business Membership (BM): A membership that runs December 1 through November 30 and is issued to a business or organization directly by USDF. The USDF BM (\$280) offers a wider variety of advertising benefits. BMs satisfy requirements of horse ownership only.

Non-Member (NM) Identification Number: For each USDF NM owner/lessee and USDF NM rider there will be a USDF NM fee of \$55 per competition that must be collected by the show secretary and submitted to USDF, along with the USDF Report of Fees document and the \$5 affidavit fee and Competition Affidavit Form if the person cannot provide a copy of their USDF NM card. Owners/lessees or riders exempt from the NM number requirements are also exempt from paying the USDF NM fee. If there are multiple owners of a horse and all are NMs, only one of the owners must pay the NM fee. If the horse has at least one owner who is a current USDF PM, GM, or BM there is no NM fee assessed. Competition management will be invoiced for all applicable USDF NM fees not received with the USDF post-competition paperwork, along with a report listing all USDF NMs. Competition management is then required to submit the NM fees within 30 days to the USDF. An individual with a USDF NM identification number is not eligible for any USDF membership benefits. Once a USDF NM number has been assigned, a USDF NM card can be obtained from the USDF website.

Horse Identification (HID) Number: A one-time tracking number for horses (\$45). Scores earned by a horse with an HID number will be recorded but will NOT be counted towards Adequan /USDF Year-End Awards. A horse with an HID number is not eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying or championship classes. An HID number can be upgraded to a Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) for a fee of \$95. If a horse has a USDF LHR it does not need an HID number. An HID number is a one-time fee that does not need to be renewed.

Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR): A horse with an LHR (\$140) is eligible for Adequan@/USDF Year-End Awards, and eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying and championship classes, assuming requirements for the owner and rider are met. If a horse has an LHR it does not need an HID number. An LHR does not need to be renewed.

How to Join USDF

Applications for USDF Participating Membership (PM), Business Membership (BM), Horse Identification (HID) number, and Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) may be found in the following locations:

- On the USDF website: www.usdf.org. You can submit the application online or download the form.
- In the show office at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions classified by USEF as Dressage Competitions, and Regular Competitions which are open to all breeds.

The effective date of membership is the date the form and correct fees are received in the USDF office or, if applying at a competition, the date accepted by the competition secretary, provided the application is signed and dated by the competition secretary, member, and/or horse owner on that same day.

USDF Statement on Animal Welfare

The United States Dressage Federation, Inc. (USDF), a federation of individual members and over 100 independent organizations throughout the United States, supports the concept of ethical treatment of animals.

Dressage is a classical method of training horses, based upon the horse's natural responses, as carried out in a gradual, planned program during which the horse's athletic abilities are improved in a systematic manner. As a result, the horse becomes capable, comfortable, and responsive in partnership with the rider without the use of force. Dressage competition at various levels of achievement is the ultimate test of the training program to determine whether the desired harmony between horse and rider has been achieved.

The rules pertaining to dressage competition prohibit the use of artificial appliances, training aids, and drugs, which would force the horse to submit. Instead, the emphasis is upon training and a cooperative partnership with the rider. Major competitions are carefully monitored to assure that there is no unnecessary force or harshness displayed.

Unlike other horse sports in which horses enter training at a relatively immature state, dressage training is usually not seriously begun until the horse is three or four. The top levels of achievement require five or more years of progressive training and it is not unusual to see horses in international competition in their late teens. This, in itself, places a premium on good care and soundness throughout the horse's life.

While supporting the concept of animal welfare in its broadest form, the United States Dressage Federation, Inc., also recognizes that it is unrealistic to ascribe human emotions and responses to the horse which in its wild state is a creature of flight, living a hard and precarious existence. Under domestication, the horse is assured of ample food, water, and shelter, as well as protection against infectious diseases and damaging parasites, thus leading a longer and healthier life with a high rate of survival.

As an educational organization, USDF has numerous programs, which teach people how to pursue the accepted, humane training methods. A program of certifying instructors also emphasizes protecting the horse's welfare in pursuit of dressage training.
