

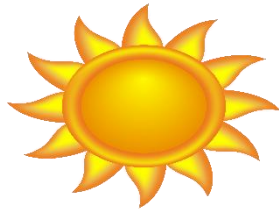

Learning Theme for the Month is Summer!!!!

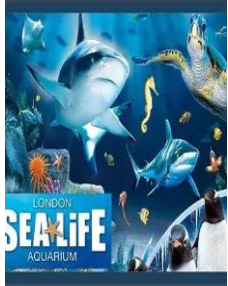


This month the children will explore the session of Summer activities that takes place during the season. The topic will encourage the children to communicate and engage in conversations about their own summer experiences
