

To whom it may concern,

Pursuant to the Oklahoma Open Records Act, 51 O.S. §§ 24A.1 et seq., this letter serves as a follow-up to my prior request received by the City on February 23, 2026, regarding records related to the City's code enforcement initiative and associated matters.

I previously submitted a follow-up inquiry on March 17, 2026, requesting a status update and offering to inspect records in person to reduce staff time and costs.

As of the date of this correspondence, a substantial amount of time has elapsed since receipt of the original request. While I understand that certain portions of the request may require additional time for review, redaction, or consultation with counsel, I have not received responsive records or a substantive written update within a reasonable timeframe under the circumstances, particularly given the focused subject matter of the request.

To facilitate timely and efficient compliance, I understand that responsive records may be provided on a rolling basis as they become available, including any partial production currently ready.

Given the time already elapsed, I respectfully request that all responsive records currently available be provided no later than the close of business on Friday, March 27, 2026.

If any portion of the request requires additional time, I ask that the City provide a written update describing the status of the request and the estimated timeframe for completion.

If I do not receive a response or responsive records within that timeframe, I will consider other remedies available under the Oklahoma Open Records Act.

As previously stated, I prefer electronic copies where available and remain willing to pay reasonable fees as permitted by law.
