

To whom it may concern,

I am writing to clarify and narrow the scope of my Open Records Request dated March 23, 2026, regarding streets and alleys within the City of Shidler.

While the original request referenced records dating back to the city's founding in 1921, my intent is **not** to request a complete historical search of all records from that date forward. Rather, my request is limited to any official actions, authorizations, permissions, agreements, licenses, leases, maps, plats, or other records—regardless of when created—that are **currently in effect** and that allow private individuals or entities to occupy, enclose, fence, or otherwise use platted public rights-of-way within the Southside Addition and Original Town (OT) Shidler.

I am not requesting records of actions that no longer have any present legal effect or practical impact on the current status of these rights-of-way.

This is a **non-commercial request made in the public interest**. As a taxpayer, I am seeking to understand the current status and use of public rights-of-way and to promote transparency regarding any authorizations or actions affecting those rights.

I continue to prefer to **inspect the responsive records in person** and will make my own copies as permitted by the Open Records Act. I also confirm that this request does not require the City to create any new records.

Please proceed with processing my request under this clarified and narrowed scope and advise me when the records will be available for inspection.
