

**LEAF COLOR:** Summer Dense dark green foliage that turns yellow in the fall retaining late into the fall. The bark is white and smooth with slight exfoliation when mature. Bark goes through a transitional phase from grayish-orange on 3yr-old stems, orange-white on 6yr-old-stems to yellow-white on mature trunks.

HABIT: Shape is upright pyramidal narrow columnar

**CULTURE:** Above average tolerance to bronze birch borer, and strong winds. Adaptable to both dry and moist locations. It is not particular as to soil pH. It is highly tolerant of urban pollution and heat and drought. Light

**GROWTH RATE:** Medium - Fast

FLOWER/FRUIT: not ornamentally significant.

Apply to **BIRCH** Annually Care: Follow a regular watering schedule during the first & second growing season to establish a deep, extensive root system. Watering can be reduced after establishment. Feed with a general purpose fertilize before new growth begins in spring.
